Heating is provided via electric storage heaters, the property is double glazed throughout.

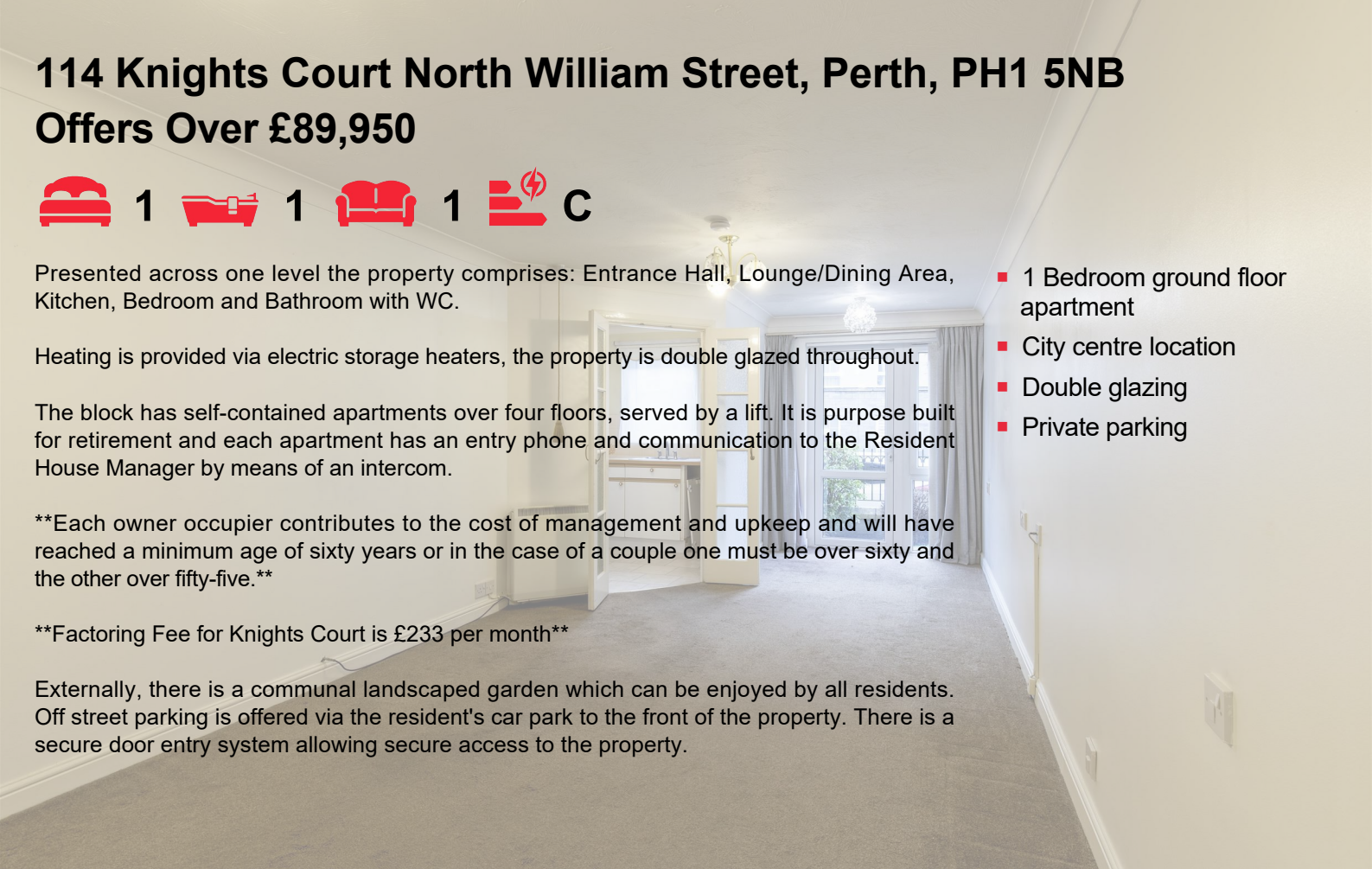

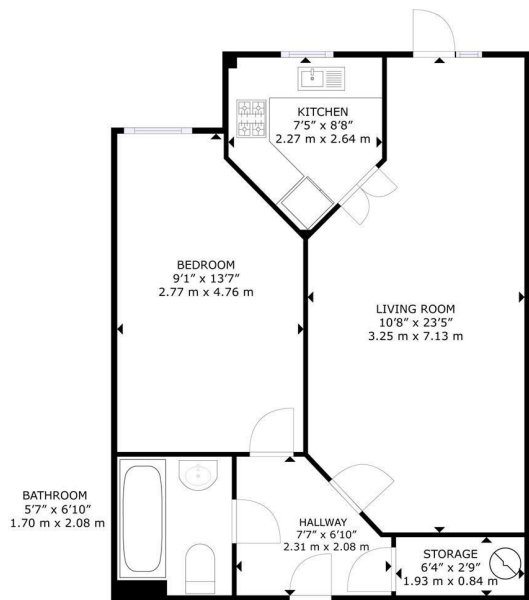

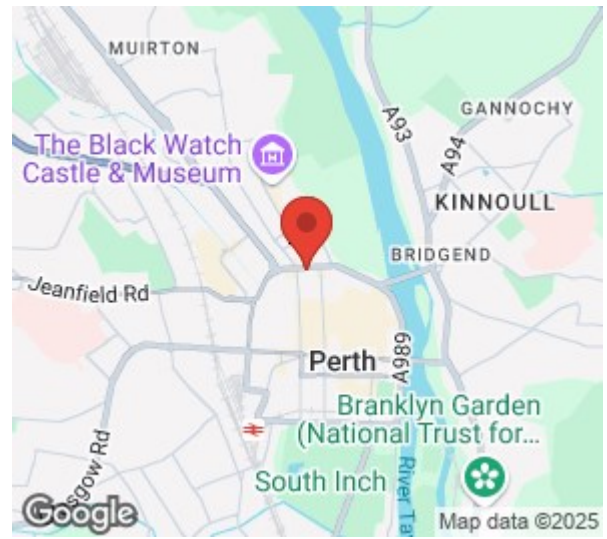
