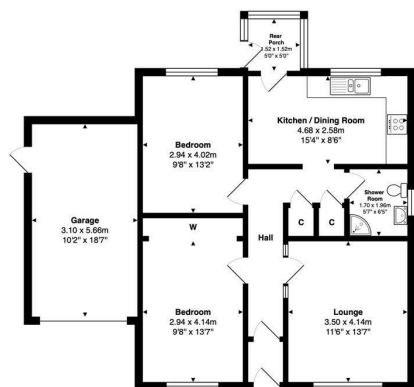
Comfort and warmth are assured via gas central heating and double glazing throughout.
