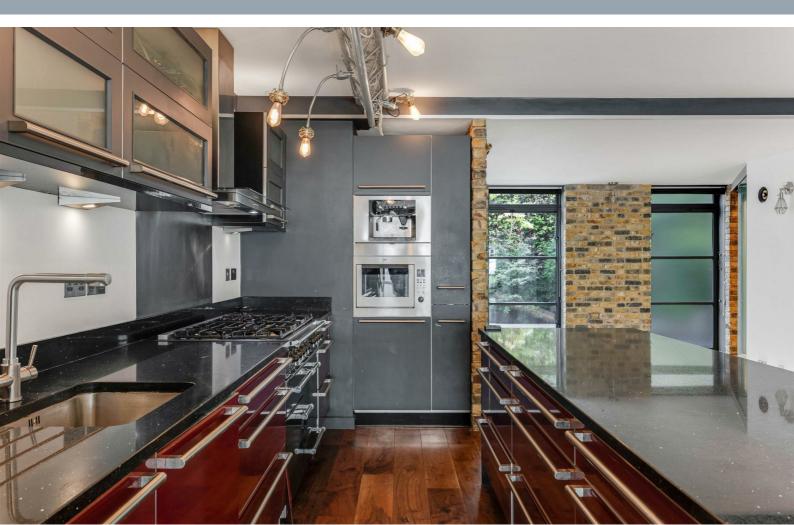

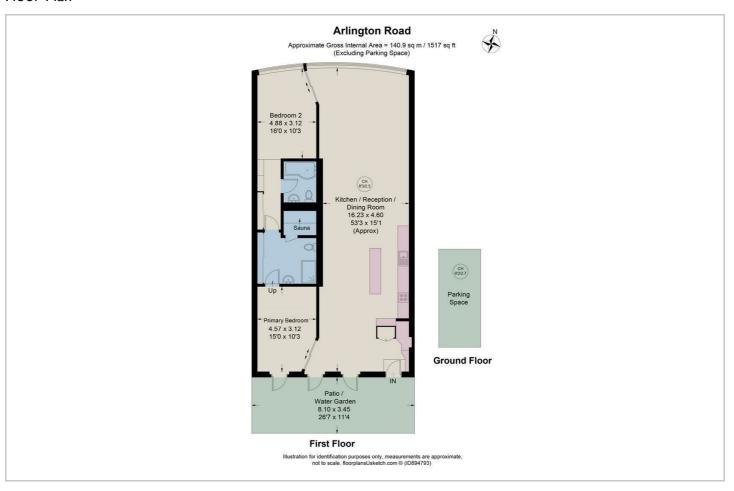

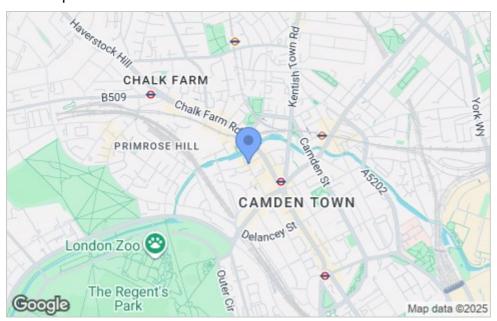




Floor Plan



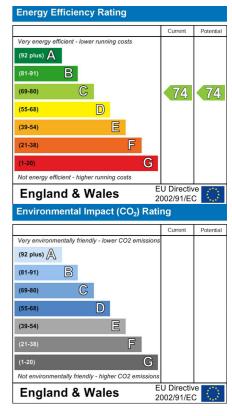
Area Map
