Rose Meadow is within commuting distance of both Chester and Manchester offering both convenient road links and regular public transport. Rose Meadow is eight miles from junction 19 on the M6 for the north, and 8.4 miles from junction 18 of the M6 for the south. Junction 11 of the M56 is 8.8 miles away which links Chester and South Manchester. Those travelling by public transport will find a bus stop a short walk from home with services offering routes to Northwich town centre, Davenham, Winsford, Middlewich, Sandbach and Crewe.

Northwich and Greenbank train stations, both around 1.5 miles away, provide services to Manchester Piccadilly (57 mins), Knutsford (11 mins) and Chester (33 mins). For those requiring international travel, Manchester airport is less than 30 minutes away by car.

For everyday conveniences, Northwich boasts a thriving shopping area with a pleasant pedestrianised high street and bustling market hall. Here, shoppers will find a great mix of brand name stores independent boutliques and specialist shops



Northwich Artisan Market has become an institution in the town specialising in high-quality goods from award-winning traders. Held on the second Saturday of every month in the popular Witton Street shopping area, this extensive market presents everything from hand-made crafts to organic fruit and vegetables. Rose Meadow also benefits from a prime position close to a number of charming market towns.

The vibrant town of Northwich is home to some popular outdoor leisure pursuits which capture the beauty of the Cheshire countryside. The Northwich Woodlands located north of the town centre, is made of up nine fascinating countryside sites, covering 350 hectares of parkland.

Marbury Country Park is a beautiful public green space just over three miles from Rose Meadow, which links with the North Cheshire Way and a number of national cycling routes. The area is also popular with walkers, families and nature lovers, boasting wonderful waterside views, lime avenues and an orchard, alongside a fully-equipped children's play area to keep younger visitors entertained

For everyday fitness, Northwich Memorial Court is less than a mile from the development on foot and is a popular leisure and entertainment venue. Here, residents will find a state-of-the-art gym, alongside two swimming pools and a varied fitness class timetable. The venue is also home to a large entertainment space which holds regular comedy nights, live music performances and theatre shows

For families, there are a range of popular primary schools within close proximity of the development, including Leftwich Community Primary School, which is just five minutes away by car. Residents will also find the well-rated Kingsmead Primary School, Charles Darwin Community Primary School, and Witton Church Walk Church of England Primary School, all located around a mile from Rose Meadow. Secondary schools in the area are equally impressive, and also can be reached within a short drive. These include The County High School Leftwich (0.8 miles), St. Nicholas Catholic High School (0.8 miles) and Hartford Church of England High School (1.3 miles)

Those pursuing further study may consider one of the three award-winning universities within a 50 minute drive: the University of Chester, the University of Manchester and the University of Liverpool.
