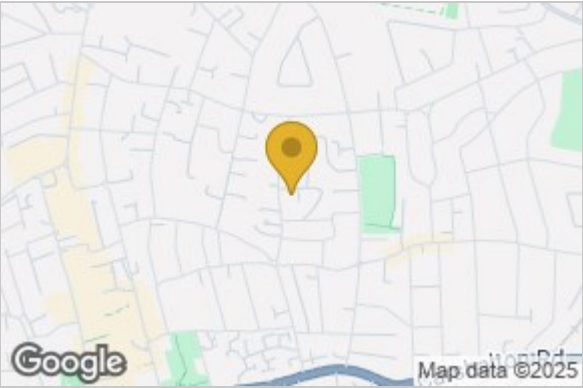

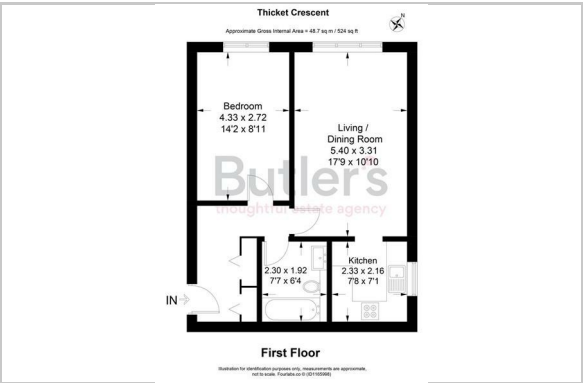
Residents Parking



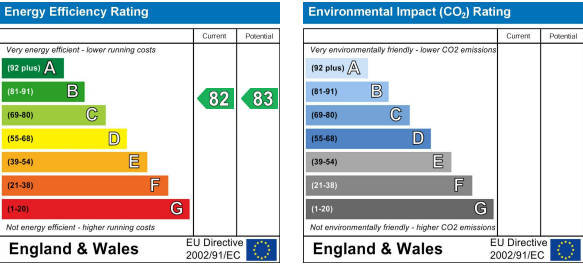
Area Map
