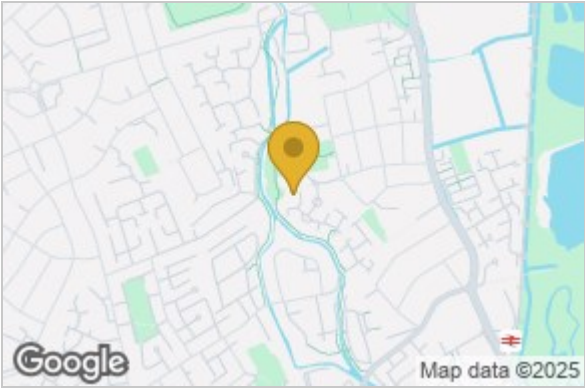

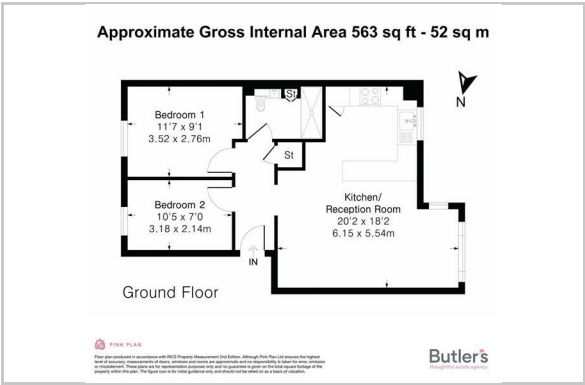

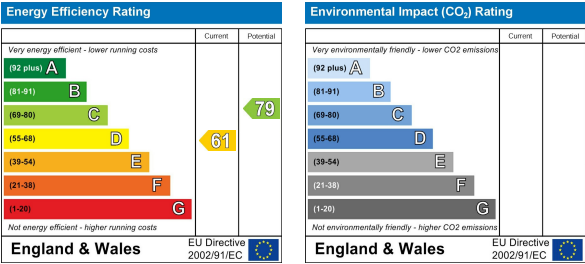
Area Map
