The property benefits from UPVc double glazing throughout and gas fired central heating and is considered to be well presented having been maintained by the current owners with updated modern shower room and neutral decor throughout. The property is leasehold and benefits from a long lease term.

The living accommodation is spacious an open plan to the well equipped kitchen. The bedrooms are both doubles and there is storage cupboard together with a sizeable loft space which has been boarded and has a fitted ladder.

UPVc stable door to front. Double aspect room with double glazed windows to front and side. Hardwearing vinyl flooring. Radiator. Coved ceiling. Telephone point. Open to kitchen.

**Kitchen** - 3.51m x 2.08m (11'6" x 6'10")

Double aspect room with double glazed windows to side and rear. Hardwearing vinyl flooring and partially tiled walls. Fully fitted with a range of wall and base units housing integral washing machine and dishwasher with space for fridge/freezer. Built in single electric oven. Work surfaces with inset 4 burner electric hob with fitted stainless steel cooker hood and inset stainless steel sink and drainer unit.

Double glazed window to front. Hardwearing vinyl flooring. Coved ceiling. Radiator. Loft access, which is large with a fitted ladder, and houses the boiler.

Hardwearing vinyl flooring. Deep built in cupboard with fitted shelving. Loft access. **Bedroom One** - 3.33m x 2.95m (10'11" x 9'8")

Double glazed window to rear. Hardwearing vinyl flooring. Coved ceiling. Radiator. **Shower Room** - 2.29m x 1.63m (7'6" x 5'4")

Double glazed opaque window to rear. Hardwearing vinyl flooring and fully tiled walls. Modern towel rail. Extractor fan. White suite compromising of walk in shower cubicle, wash hand basin set within vanity unit and W.C.
