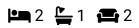

Steeped in history, the first recorded occupier was Catherine Taylor, a butler's wife in 1881. Today, the property combines period charm with modern living, while offering exciting potential for extension and conversion.

On the ground floor, a spacious reception/dining room runs the length of the house, creating a versatile open-plan living space full of character. To the rear sits a fitted kitchen and a delightful garden room leading directly onto the south-facing garden.

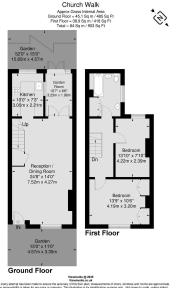
Upstairs, the first floor provides two well-proportioned bedrooms and a family bathroom, each accessed via the landing.

Externally, the cottage boasts a beautifully landscaped and extensively planted evergreen garden, enjoying a sunny southerly aspect. At the far end is a gate opening onto Parish Hall car park, adding practicality to the charm. The front door of the cottage opens onto a pretty front garden which leads into delightful Church Walk.

The property also offers significant scope, with potential for a loft conversion and a rear ground-floor extension (subject to planning permission). Offered chain-free, this home is ready for its next chapter.

Located in one of Leatherhead's most sought-after positions, residents benefit from excellent amenities nearby: Nuffield Gym, Waitrose, the theatre and cinema, and the public library are all within a few minutes' walk, while the train station offers fast services to London Victoria and Waterloo.
