





The woodland comprises a varied landscape of open glades, meandering pathways, and mature tree cover, offering a diverse mix of native species such as English oak, beech, sycamore, horse chestnut, rowan, holly, silver birch, and hazel. This variety supports a thriving ecosystem, providing important habitat for local wildlife including birds and small mammals. Its status as ancient woodland enhances both its ecological significance and its long-term preservation potential.

A well-formed track runs through the heart of the site, offering excellent vehicular access directly from the main road. The combination of woodland seclusion and riverside access makes this an ideal location for those seeking a peaceful escape with the opportunity to enjoy time by the water.

With its outstanding natural beauty, recreational potential, and strong transport links, Winnington Wood represents a rare and valuable opportunity to own a significant piece of the British countryside.
