n exceptional home, with its Aelegant brick and flint exterior, 10 Patternmakers Close gifts generous proportions throughout - and some rather stunning views too...

On entering the home, the sense of space strikes you immediately. From the wide and welcoming entrance hall to the fulldepth views which draw the eye through

the entire house. Not only that, but there is also a real appreciation of natural light with both the reception room and the kitchen/dining room being triple aspect to take full advantage of the sunshine whatever the season. One of the major parts the current owners have loved most about living here is its position; the way one is able to follow the sun throughout the day, both inside and out.













The first of two principal rooms on the ground floor is the grand reception room. This room has french doors out to the patio and a central electric stove, though there's the space and chimney for a log-burning stove, meaning this is the perfect room all year round.

Arguably the most important room of any family home is the kitchen/dining room. The latter is an exceptional space. Vaulted ceilings, with cross beams over, create an air of period grandeur and this is balanced seamlessly with the stylish and contemporary kitchen, with its sociable central island, accompanied by views out to St Margaret's Church - forming the perfect picture as you look out over the fields. There is ample space for a large formal dining table, and a more relaxed breakfast table, with bi-fold doors taking you out onto the patio beyond.

After a spring beach walk, or muddier autumn one, the separate utility room and side door are perfect for leaving those sandy or muddy shoes behind. A shower room complements the ground floor study, which could easily be used as a downstairs bedroom - should you so desire.

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pstairs there are four generous bedrooms, and the principal suite has a vaulted ceiling, a segregated dressing area and an en-suite shower room. Once more, the church is beautifully framed in the distance and gives a wonderful awakening view.

The stunning view from this bedroom has also been the best spot for bird watching, for our client. When geese are flying, it's bird book and binoculars in hand to watch their majestic flight from the comfort of the bedroom suite.

The guest suite has a shower room as well, and there is also a large family bathroom, with a separate shower cubicle. One of the other two bedrooms is currently a home office, but both of these rooms have builtin, folding, full-sized single beds - ideal for when guests have come to stay.





















Outside the garden has a large patio, immediately off the two main living spaces, and there is a further decked area in the north-eastern corner of the garden. Its position takes maximum advantage of the late afternoon and evening sunshine and there's certainly no better place for a pre-dinner cocktail or two.

The remainder of the garden is laid to lawn and the current owners had the foresight to plant evergreen trees which were already 15-years-old, meaning they have now grown further to create an almost completely private area.

To the front of the house there is private parking for at least four cars, as well as a double garage which has a boarded loft - and a staircase up to it.

Both Fleur and Hill have built their reputations on attention to detail and that is evident in every aspect of this house. Since then, it has become a home-from-home for the current owners, but it is now time for a new family to start making their own memories here...

For a little culture, peruse Burnham Market's art galleries – the Fairfax Gallery has been exhibiting for more than 20 years and Pococks the Artmonger has an eclectic display. Or if you have little ones in tow, don't miss a trip to Mable's – unmissable with its pretty pink frontage – where you can encourage their artistic talent with a pot painting session or treat them to a bag of traditional sweets.
