What is immediately apparent about Long Meadow is the opulence of the ground floor living and entertaining space. From the generous and welcoming entrance hall you are naturally drawn into the breathtaking centrepiece, the triple height reception room. With almost church-like proportions this room is simply stunning. Whether your eyes are drawn upwards to the vaulted ceiling with exposed beams, towards the incredibly grand stone fireplace - which would not look incongruous in a medieval manor house, or out through those enormous barn style windows, across the uninterrupted farm and parkland beyond, this is a room that will make you stop in your tracks. In summer time have the bi-fold doors open and allow the cool coastal air to waft through, or come the winter and picture a roaring fire warming your back as you watch the squadrons of geese flying across that amazing vista as the sun sets.

Double doors take you through to the equally generous 37' kitchen/dining room with elegant kitchen units flanking the central island at one end, and ample space for a large dining table at the other. It is easy to picture exciting holiday adventures being planned over breakfast, followed by tales of heroics and mischief as everyone gathers again for the evening meal, drifting in from the terrace to sit and enjoy each other's company. At the other end of the house is a large home office albeit, with those stunning views in front of you, it could be a difficult room to concentrate in! Next door is the games and TV room for young and old to escape to for some time out.



The house has given us so much enjoyment over the years, whether a summer vacation or cosy Christmas by the fire.




