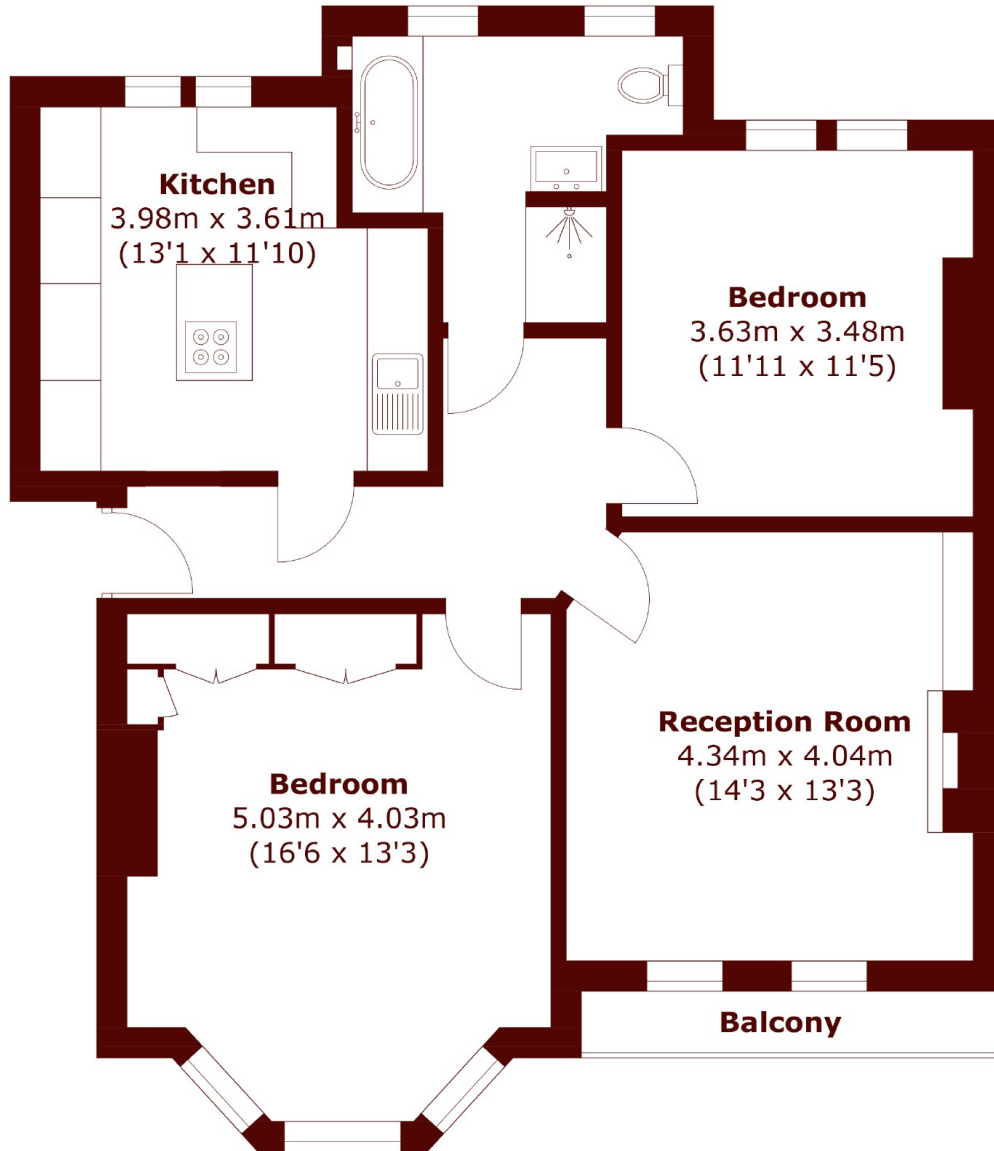
ABOUT THE PROPERTY

The apartment is flooded with light and comes with full access to the extensive private communal gardens which run along the River Thames. The characterful property enjoys high ceilings, beautiful flooring, and bespoke storage throughout. An inviting entrance hallway leads to a reception room with feature fireplace and floor-to-ceiling windows, as well as access to a private balcony. The property has two spacious double bedrooms, with bespoke cabinetry in the principal bedroom. It also benefits from a lovely, bright kitchen, with a hand-built dining area, generous fitted cabinetry and a beautifully finished bathroom with a large bath and separate shower.
