



The nearest motorway to the development is the M1 via Clifton Boulevard / A52, which is just a 20-minute drive. Journeys via these roads make travelling to Nottingham (6 miles), Derby (20 miles), Leicester (25 miles) and Chesterfield (30 miles) effortless.

If you prefer to take the train, then East Midlands Parkway Station is around an 11-minute drive from the development. From there you can take regular services to Leicester, Nottingham and London St. Pancras.
