

A charming and characterful Georgian cottage set in the historic suburl of Ballingdon, offering beautifully presented accommodation, exceptional period features, and easy access to Sudbury town centre, the water meadows and the station.

Located on the south side of the River Stour, Ballingdon retains an attractive village feel with a conservation area, listed buildings and a 13th-century bridge linking it to Sudbury. Once a separate village, it is now one of the town's most sought-after residential pockets.

This delightful period home is believed to date back to the Georgian enand was once thought to be a public house, evidenced by its impressive large cellar. Since 2021 the current owners have enhanced the property with tasteful redecoration, external cladding, a new kitchen window, a new chevron wooden floor in the lounge, exposed brickwork, new carpets to the stairs and landing and refreshed décor throughout.

The spacious entrance hallway/boot room sets the tone, featuring exposed beams, a feature wall and ample room for furniture. The cosy

yet spacious lounge is full of charm with exposed beams, parquet flooring, an open fireplace with a wooden mantle and French doors leading to the rear garden. Flooded with natural light, it is a welcoming space all year round.

To the right of the hallway, the dining room is painted in traditional Suffolk Pink and features an understairs cupboard and a cottage-style staircase rising to the first floor. Adjacent sits the bright, well-appointed kitchen, equipped with off-white units, solid wood worktops, integrated appliances and a freestanding cooker with gas hob. An exposed brick wall adds character, while a stable door opens directly to the courtyard














