Christopher's South Hams are pleased to market this charming, mid-terrace 2-bedroom home in this popular cul-de-sac close to the town centre.

The property offers a spacious sitting room with a delightful southerly aspect and useful under-stair storage. Through glazed double doors, head to the rear kitchen/diner that takes in lovely views over the garden and has double doors welcoming you to the same.

Stairs from the front door invite you to the first floor where there are two double bedrooms both with built-in wardrobes and a ceiling hatch from the landing, opens to a partially boarded loft providing additional storage. The modern family shower room boasts a double walk-in shower and completes the upstairs accommodation. Outside, there is a level driveway and space for parking 2 vehicles. A few steps lead to the front door protected by a storm porch.

High fencing, redbrick wall and mature hedging brings a great level of privacy to the fully enclosed rear garden. Offering a covered, patio seating area where the canopy perfectly provides shade on those hot days and shelter if it drizzles, this makes a superb spot to sit and take some time out, whatever the weather. Steps lead to a level lawn which leads to another patio area and timber shed. There is also an outside tap to help with those gardening jobs.

This has been a much-cherished home and is now waiting for its next generation to make their memories. Ideal for a first-time buyer or someone looking for a smaller home in a great location and viewings are highly recommended.


