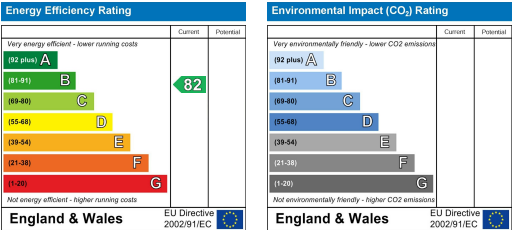
Floor Plan
