Continue down Torrington Street, under Tarka Trail bridge and follow the road to the left of Jewsons. \*The Bungalows are both none standard construction and may require specialist lending or a purchase of full cash. Essentially meaning building materials such as a former method of timber frame have been used in the construction.

Other timber frame methods are more wildly used in modern building and new build sites locally. This sits under a corrugated cement sheeting also widely used locally. For more information on this please contact the team.
