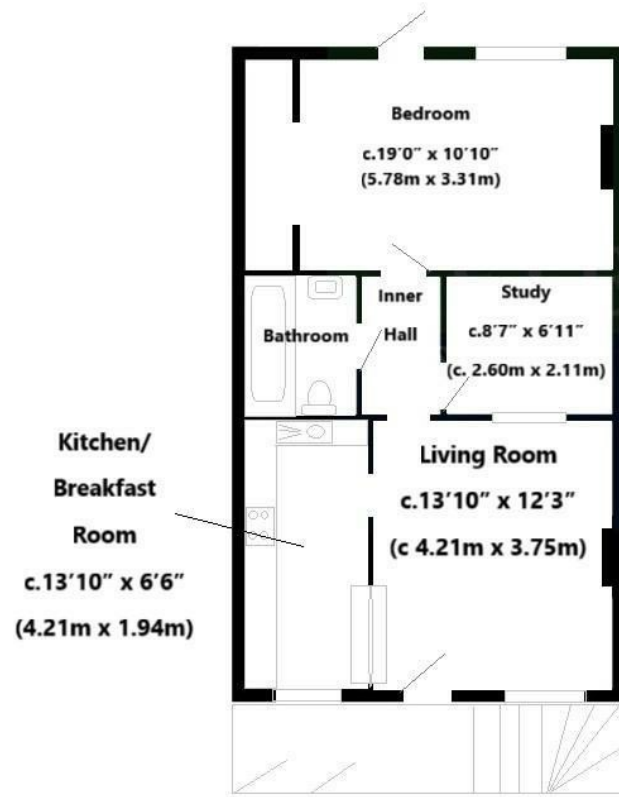

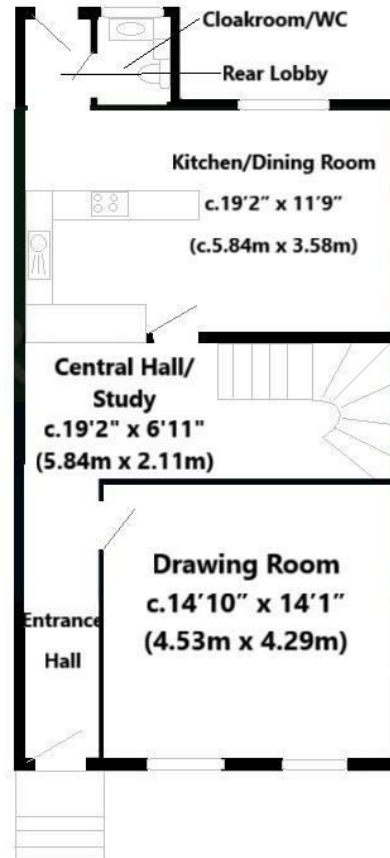

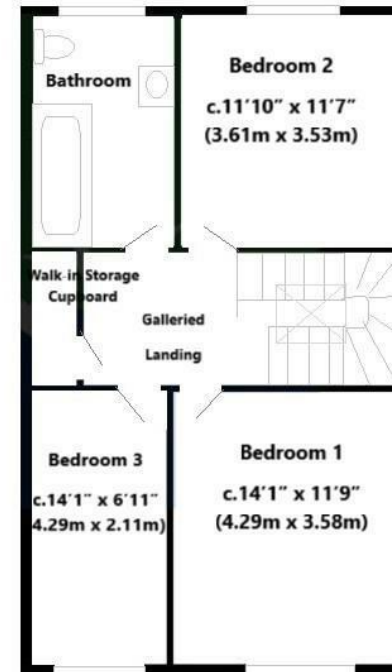

First Floor



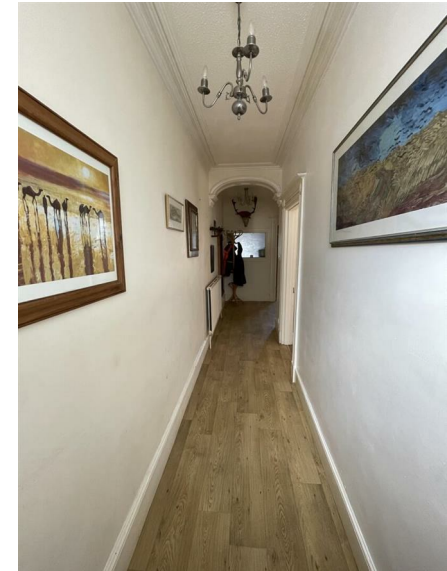
Floorplan for guidance only – not to scale

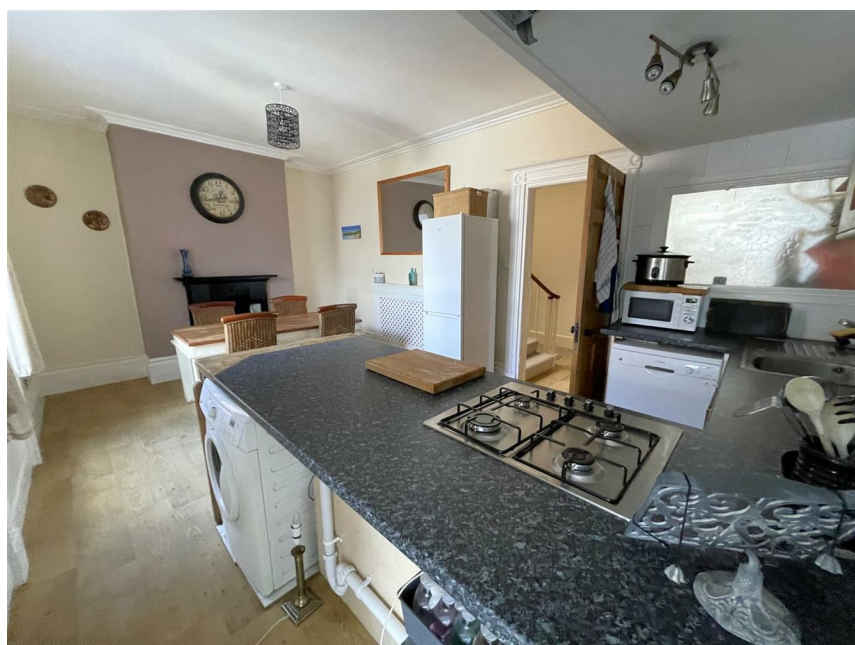

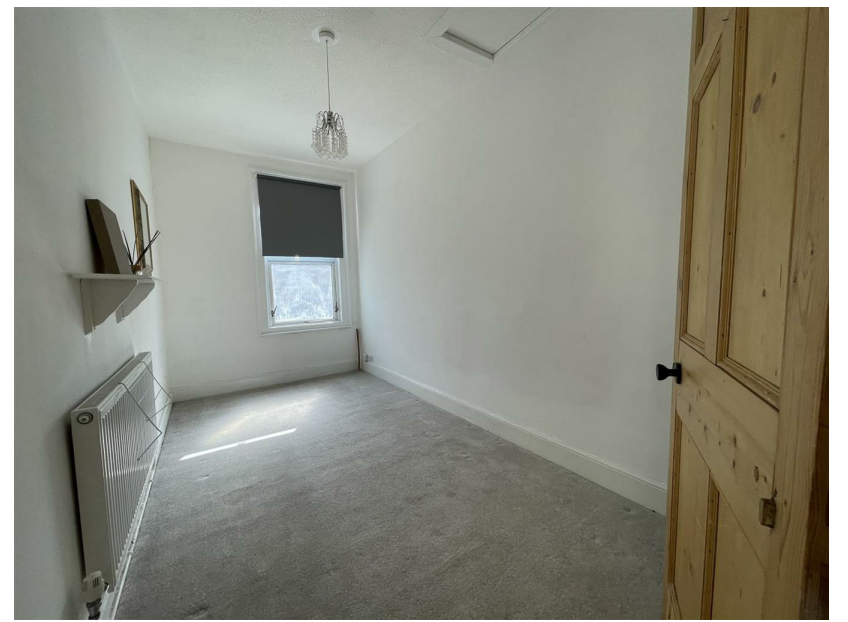
