

World-renowned for the Pink Sands Beach! Access to the island is only by boat, ferry, or chartered seaplane. The seclusion is what makes this island so special. The super-chic island, only 3.5 miles long and 1.5 miles wide has a thriving community and has long been a favourite, low-key destination for music and movie stars, and well-known names in fashion and business who often frequent such beautiful locations around the world. The stunning architecture, historic Dunmore Town, casual or fine dining, stunning boutique hotels and getting around by golf carts are just some of the things that makes Harbour Island so unique.

Getting to Harbour Island is easy! Direct flights to the North Eleuthera Airport from Nassau (capital city), Miami, Fort Lauderdale, Atlanta, and Charlotte. Or arrive by private jet to the North Eleuthera Airport. Then a five-minute taxi from airport to Three Island Dock, followed by a five-minute water taxi to Harbour Island. Alternatively, you can arrive on your own yacht. There are several marinas on the island. The closest marina to the Java Estate is Valentine's Marina just a third of a mile away. You can also arrive by chartered seaplane from Florida or Nassau direct to Harbour Island.






SATELLITE LOCATION JAVA ESTATE, Harbour Island

Nassau, the capital city is located on the island of New Providence in the Central Bahamas. The country is a coral archipelago, and limestone is the primary rock composition of the islands. With 5% of the Earth's coral, no rivers or mountains, the waters surrounding The Bahamas are virtually silt free resulting in some of the clearest waters on the planet.
