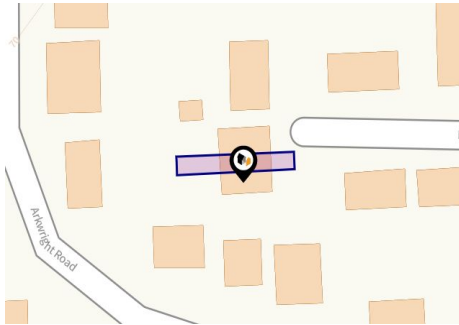

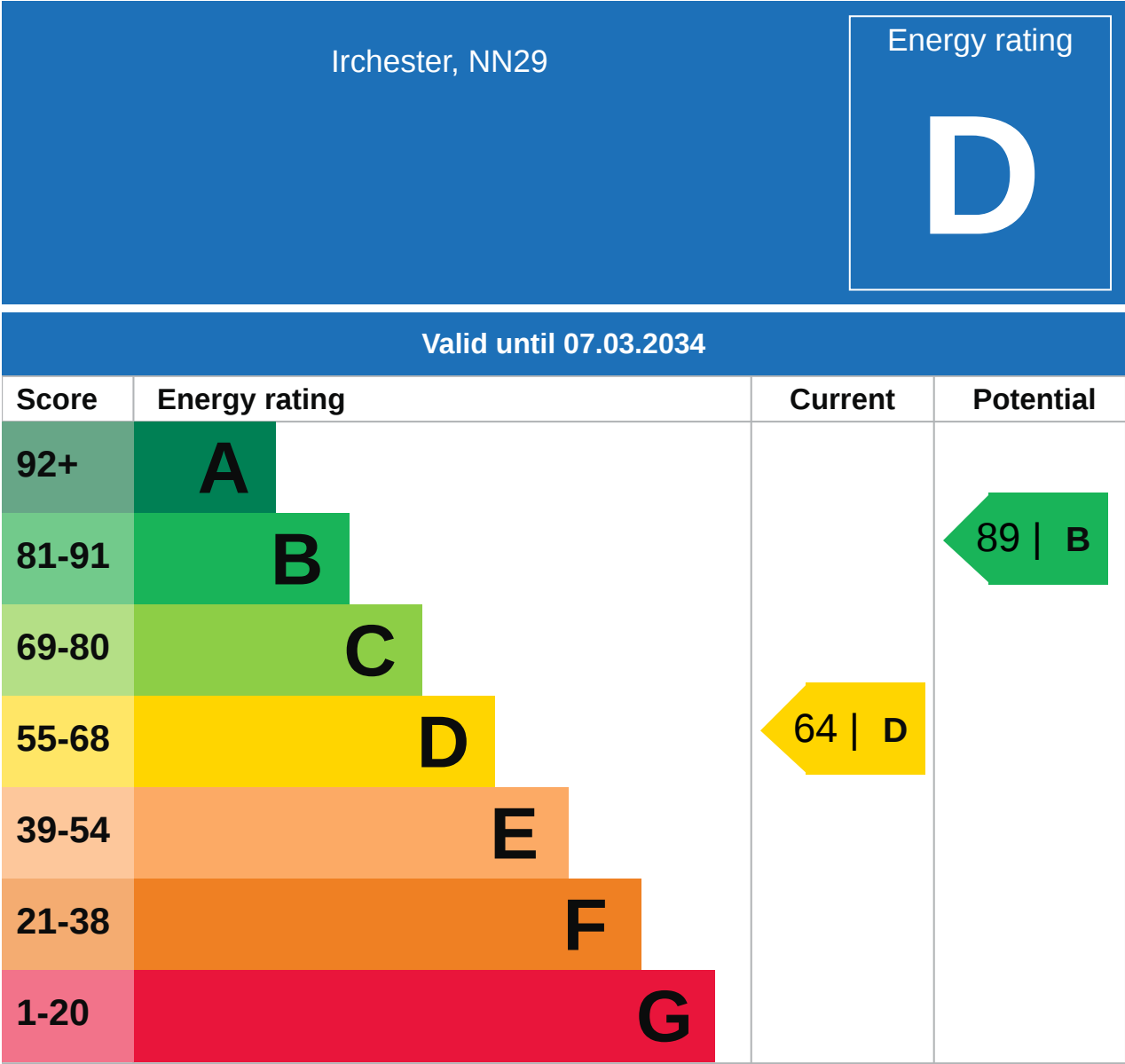

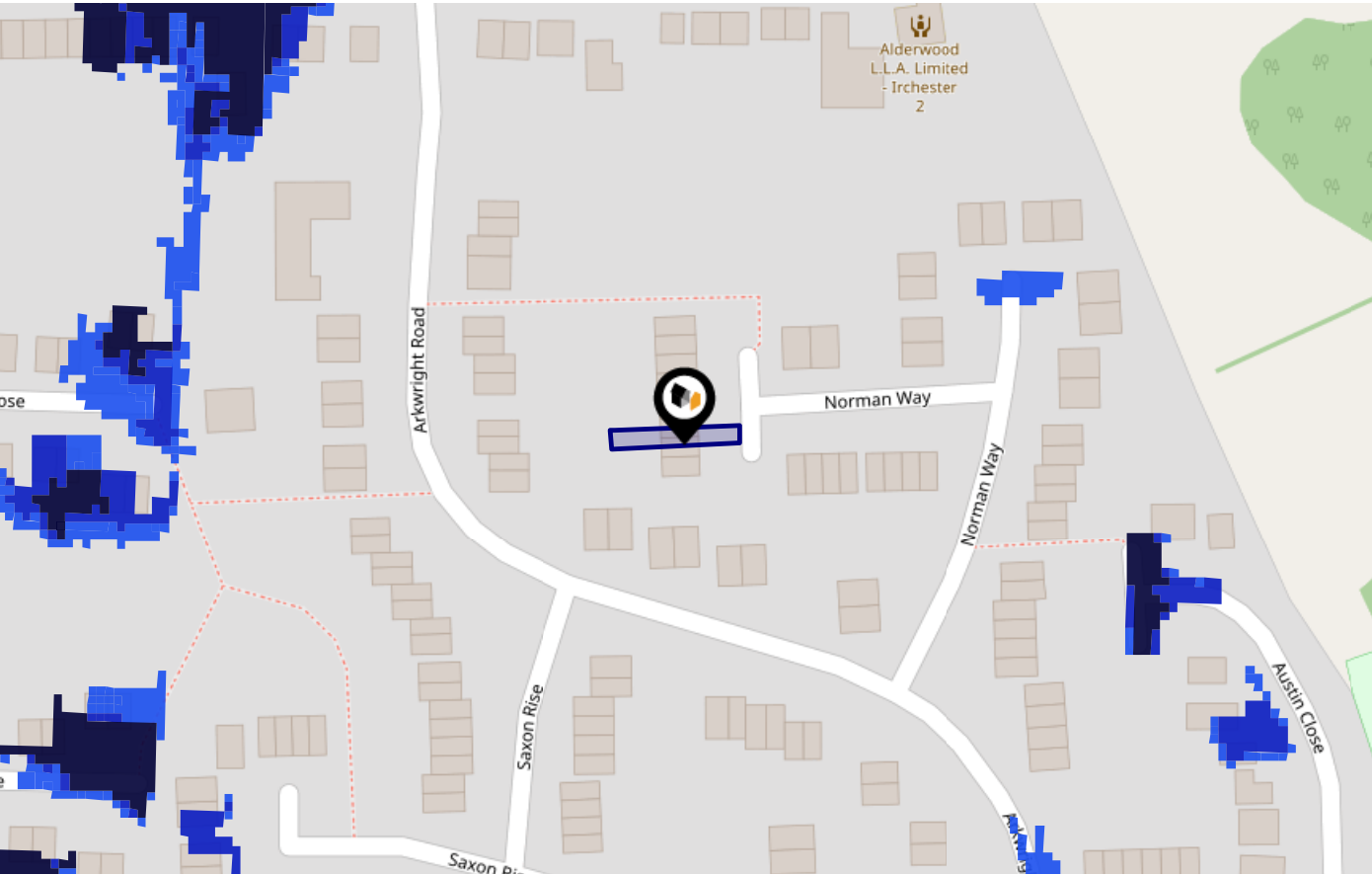

## Surface Water - Flood Risk

This map shows the chance of flooding where rainwater has nowhere to drain. This kind of flooding can occur far from rivers or seas.

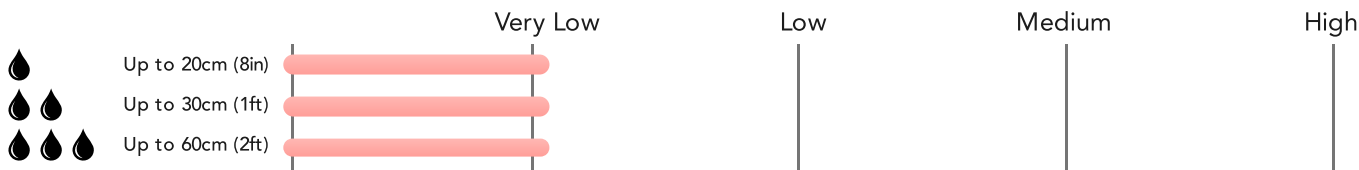


Risk Rating: Very low

Chance of flooding to the following depths at this property:



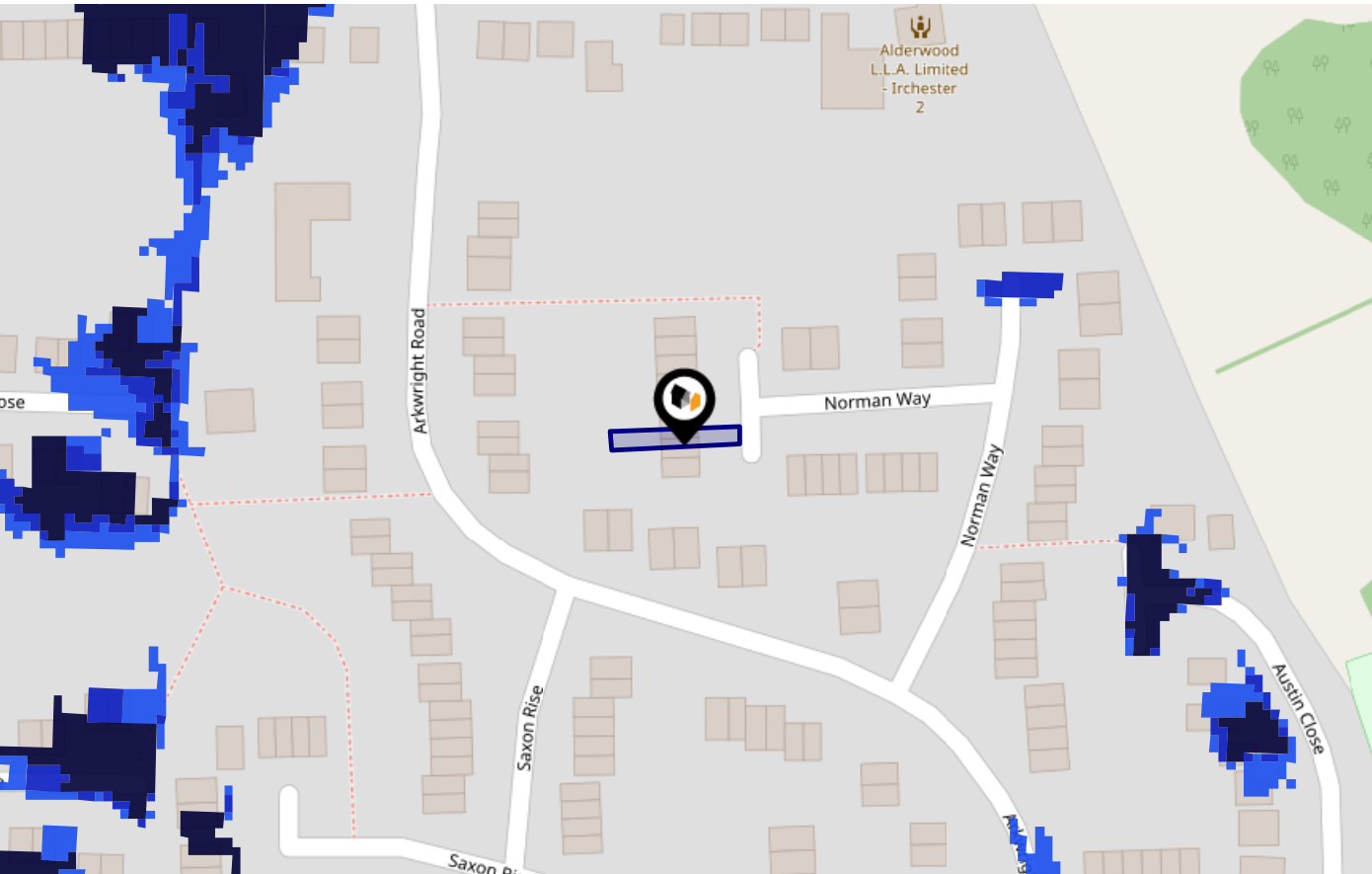

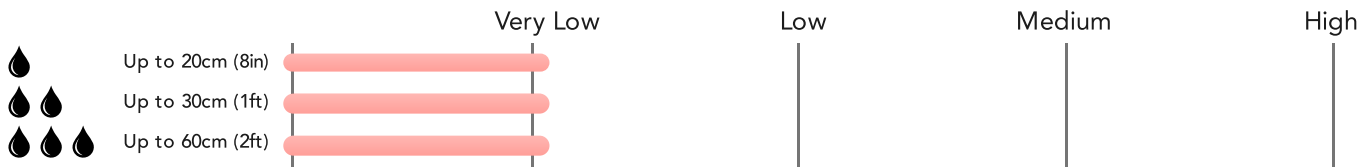

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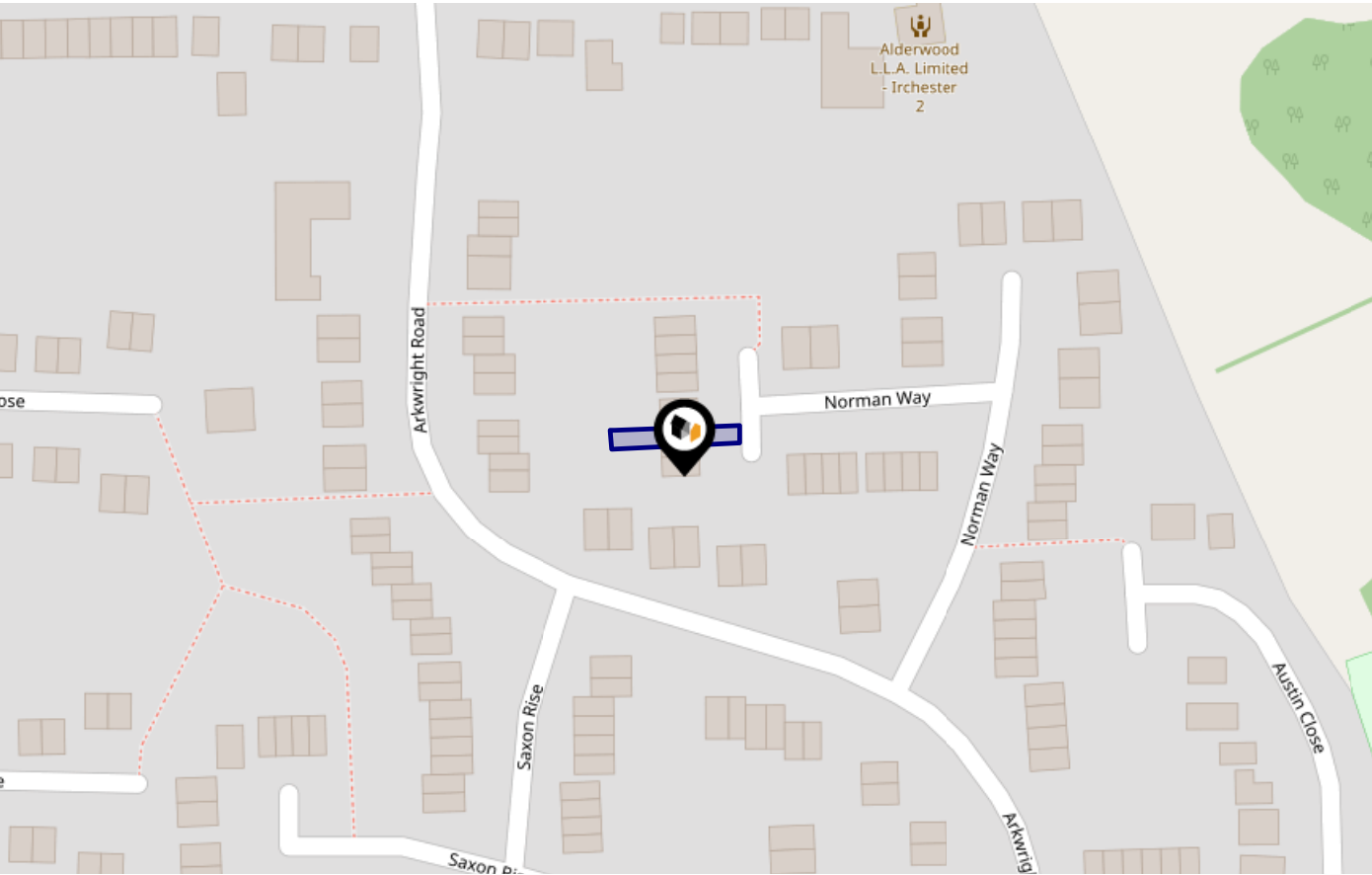

This map shows the chance of flooding from rivers and / or the sea, taking into account flood defences and their condition.

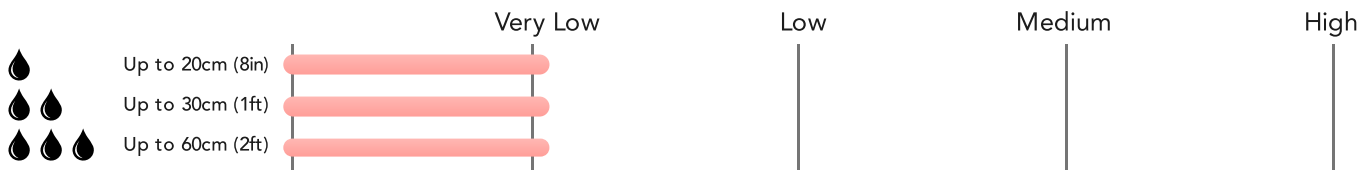

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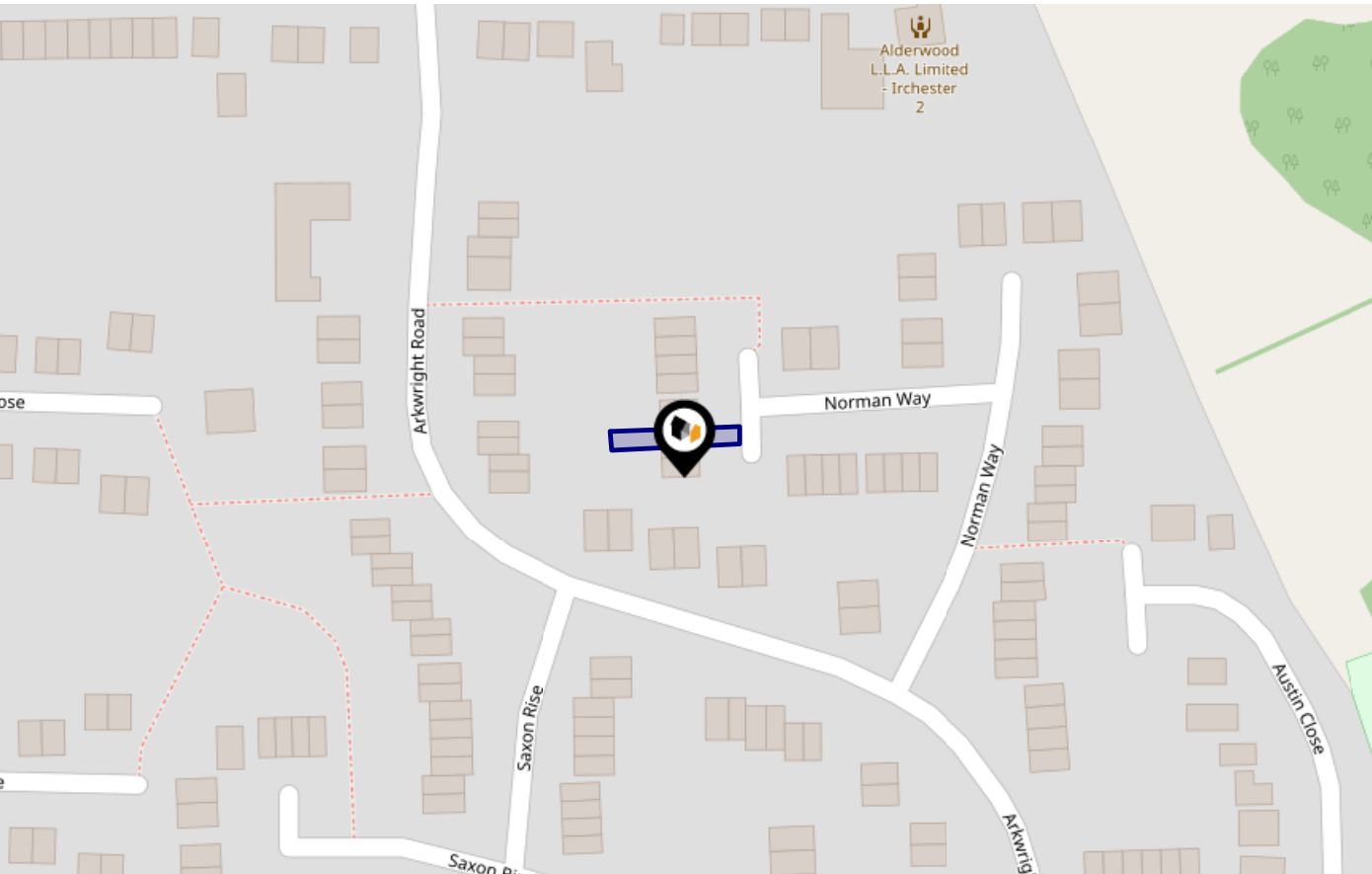

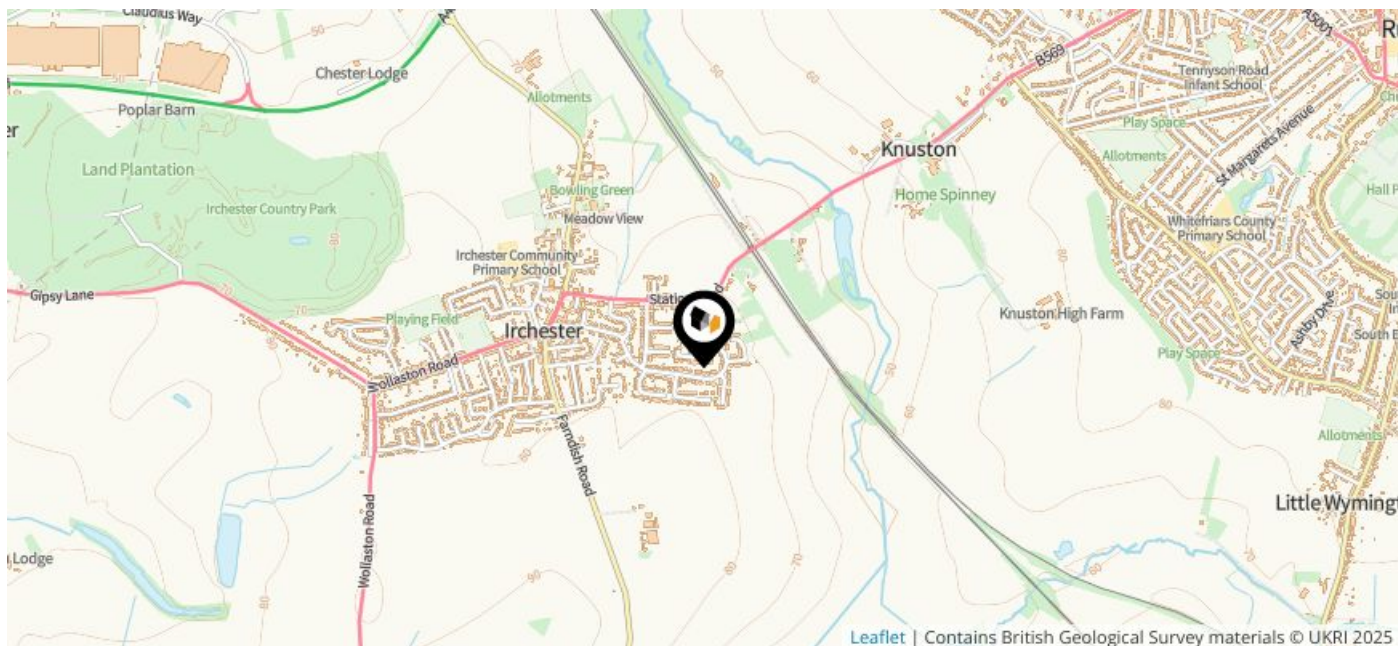

This map displays nearby coal mine entrances and their classifications.



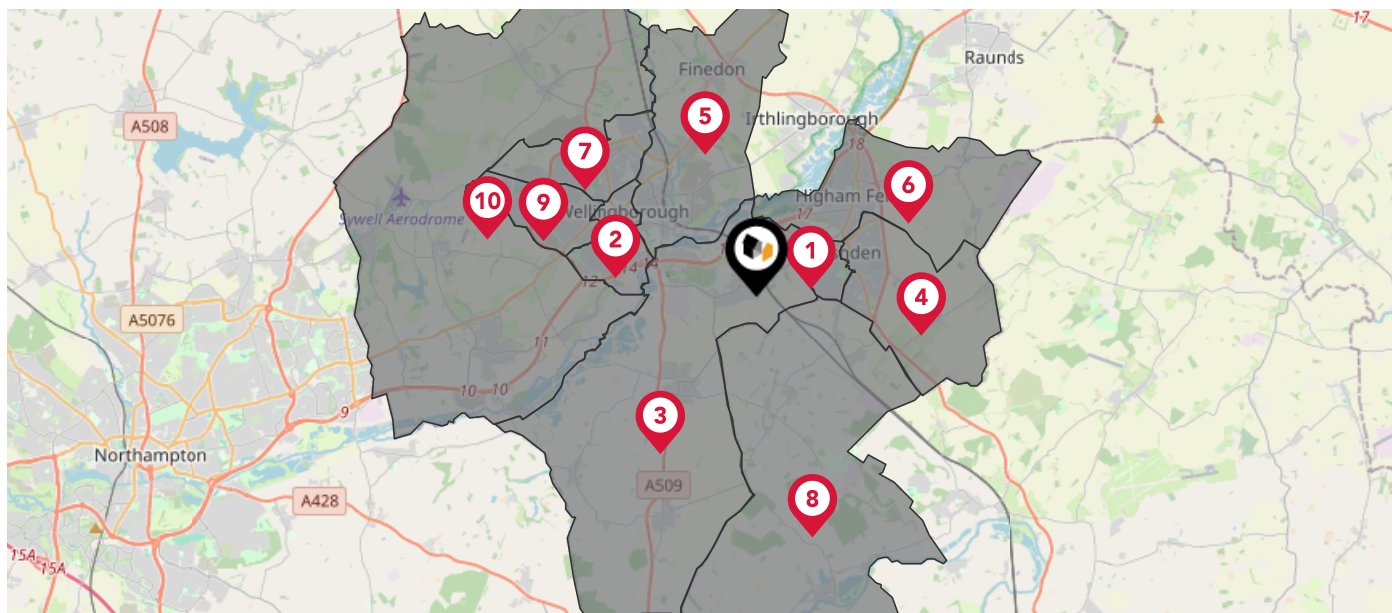

The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.

Coal mining activity is recorded as far back as the 13th century, but prior to 1872 there was no requirement to deposit abandonment plans. It is therefore believed there may be many unrecorded mine entries of which the Authority has no information or knowledge. These entries do not, therefore, appear within the Authority's national dataset as shown on this map.

The UK is divided into wards that are used for local elections to elect local government councillors. Sometimes these are known as 'electoral divisions'. Population counts can vary substantially between wards, but the national average is about 5,500

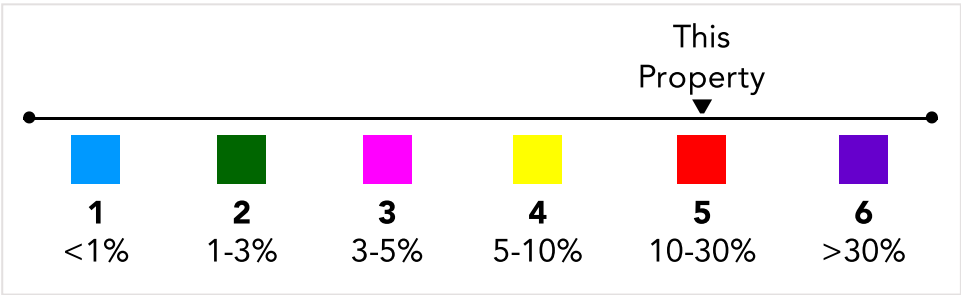
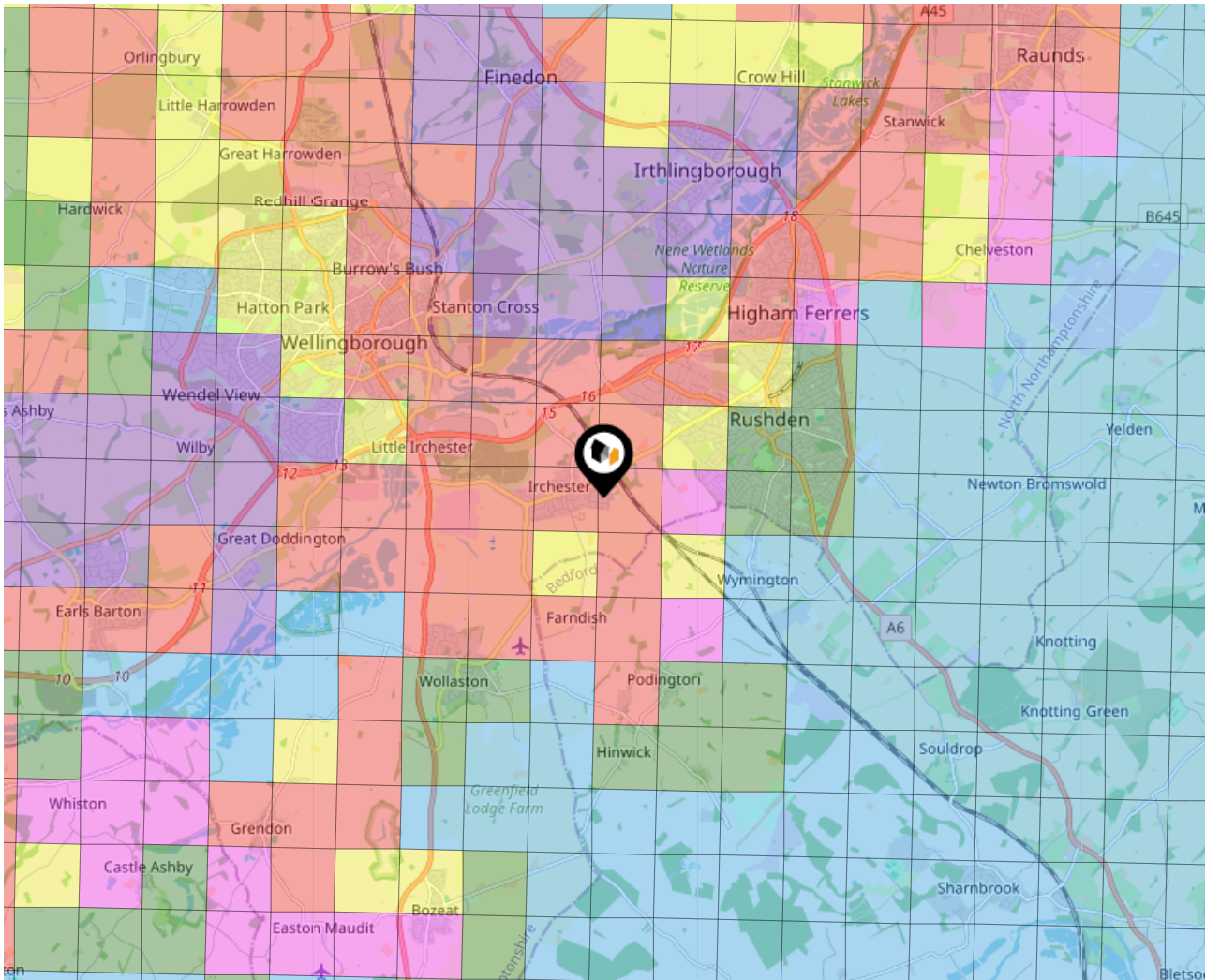

### What is Radon?

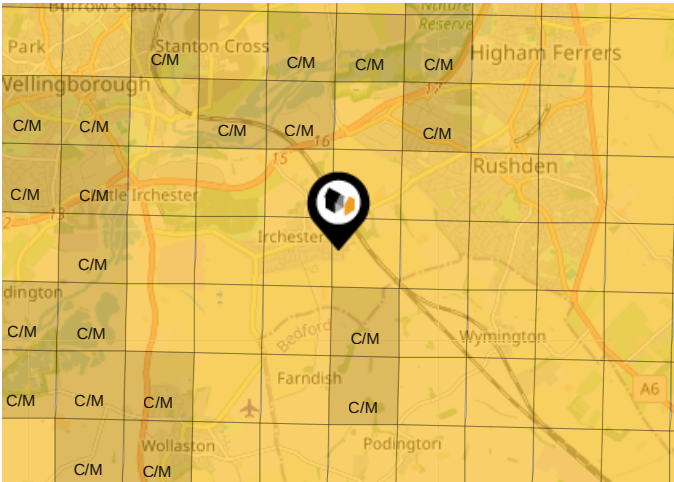
Radon is a natural radioactive gas, which enters buildings from the ground. Exposure to high concentrations increases the risk of lung cancer. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) recommends that radon levels should be reduced in homes where the annual average is at or above 200 becquerels per cubic metre (200 Bq/m<sup>3</sup>).

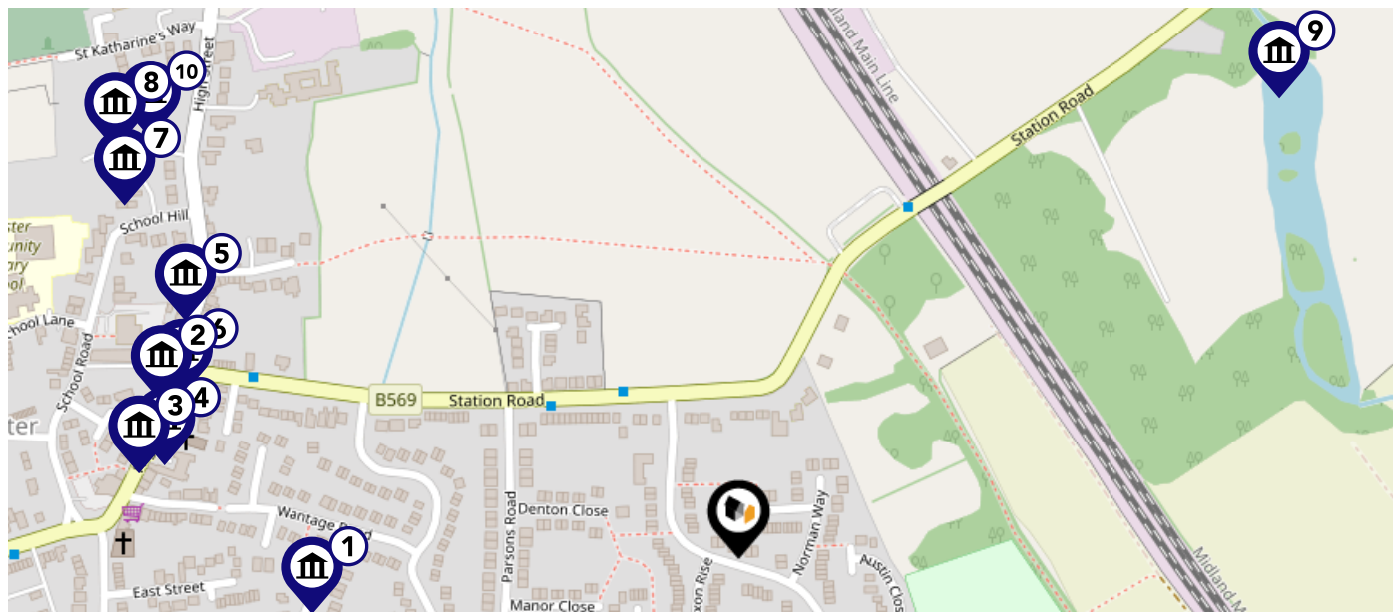

This data indicates the level of noise according to the strategic noise mapping of road sources within areas with a population of at least 100,000 people (agglomerations) and along major traffic routes. This indicates a 24 hour annual average noise level with separate weightings for the evening and night periods.

Noise levels are modelled on a 10m grid at a receptor height of 4m above ground, polygons are then produced by merging neighbouring cells within the following noise classes:

- 75.0+ dB
- 70.0-74.9 dB
- 65.0-69.9 dB
- 60.0-64.9 dB
- 55.0-59.9 dB
