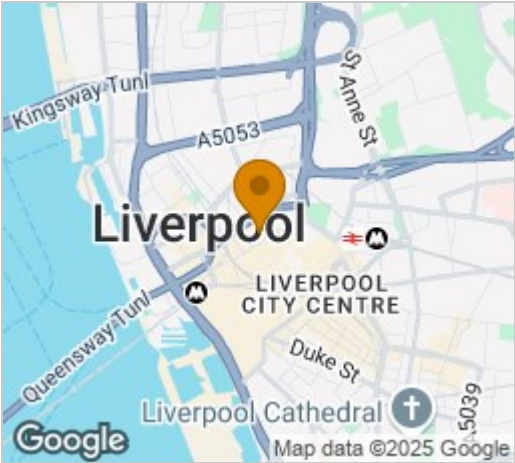

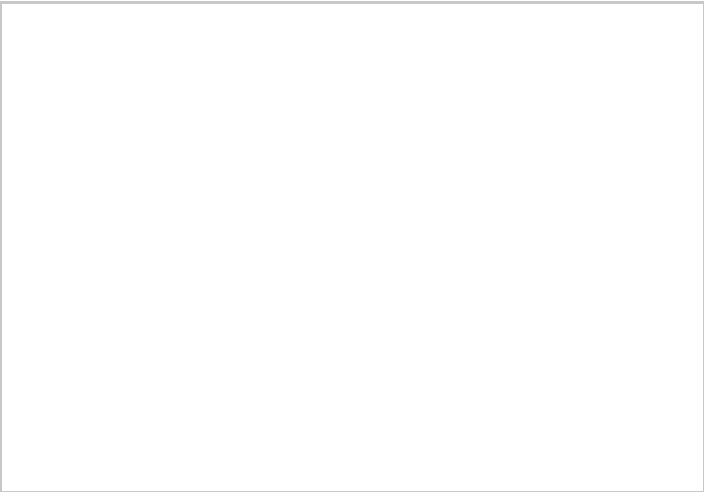
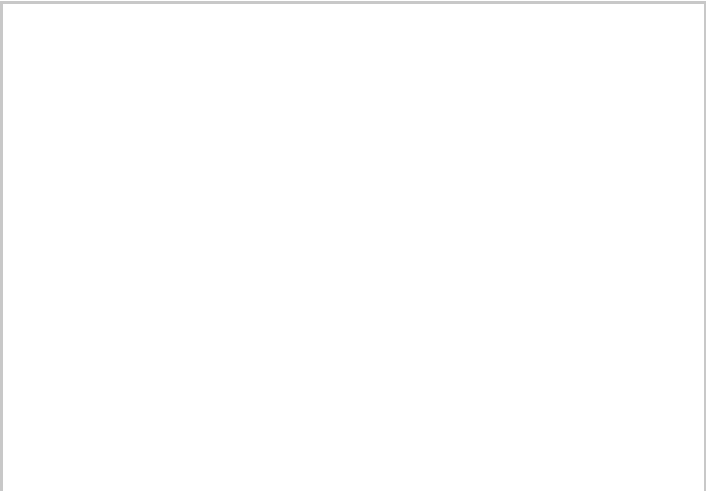
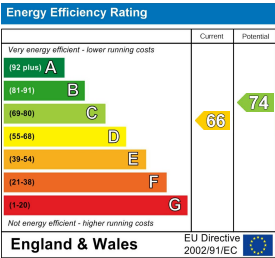
Floor Plan
