Constructed in 1957, this Seco prefabricated home has a 4 ½ inch single brick wrap to the outside and is known to have levels of asbestos within the original part of the build. Measuring approximately 79 sqm / 860 sqft, this detached home provides living accommodation over one level and due to the size of the plot of 0.13 acres, it offers potential for re-development subject to the relevant planning consents being granted.

In brief, the property comprises of two bedrooms, a family bathroom with a single enclosed shower, three reception rooms, which includes a living room, dining room, and a conservatory. The kitchen is tiled, offers a wide range of cupboards, provides ample worktop space and integrated appliances include an electric oven and a gas-fired hob.

Externally, the front of the property has a block-paved driveway with a concrete drive running to the side and up towards the detached single garage. The rear garden is fully enclosed and backs onto West Road. The rear garden is block-paved for large parts with a number of flower beds to the side. A detached, double-glazed summerhouse is situated to the middle of the garden.

Location

Histon is widely acknowledged as being one of the most sought-after villages north of Cambridge. Its particularly convenient location just 3 miles from Cambridge city centre adds to its popularity and communications are first class, the A14 and M11 being within a few minutes drive. Histon is served by Cambridgeshire County Council's Guided Busway with an estimated journey time to the Science Park of approximately 3 minutes and is a 10 minute cycle. It is also conveniently located for Cambridge North railway station.

The village boasts many local facilities including excellent schooling for all ages from pre-school to sixth form, including the well regarded Impington Village College. Good local shopping is available in the village and there is a regular bus service to Cambridge. Girton Golf Club is also within a few minutes drive.
