This 0.7 acre plot with planning permission offers an excellent development opportunity. Planning is agreed to replace an existing bungalow with a 5 bedroom two-storey property however alternative proposals may be possible subject to planning consent. The plot located in a fantastic rural location and benefits from both sweeping views of the Devon countryside and great access to Honiton, Exeter, the A30/A303 and M5. Additional adjacent land is available with separate negotiation.

Full Details

This (Approx.) 0.7 acre site offers considerable development potential. Planning has been agreed for the replacement of an existing bungalow with a 5 bedroom, two-storey property with a footprint of 3000 square foot and sweeping views of the Devon countryside. Subject to planning, alternative proposals could be submitted supported by the fact that permission is already granted for this configuration. Additional adjacent land is available through separate negotiation.

Location

The site is located in a fantastic rural location benefiting from sweeping views of the Devon countryside. The location has excellent access to the market town of Honiton (3.5 miles) where the A30 provides easy access to Exeter (22 miles) and a direct link to London via the A303. The nearby A373 (1.4 miles) connects to the M5 in 10 miles facilitating access to the M4, Bristol, Wales and the North of England.

Honiton is a busy market town and offers a great range of amenities including schools, medical and recreational facilities, coffee shops, library, restaurants, a selection of independent high street stores and supermarkets. It also offers street markets every Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Honiton Train Station provides direct connections to London and Exeter. Quick access to the A30 also provides direct access to the Cathedral city of Exeter (22 miles) which is well provisioned with high street shops and services. Exeter Airport is available in 12.5 miles (just of the A30) and Bristol airport is accessible in just over an hour (54 miles). The Southwest Coast is easily accessible with Seaton, Sidmouth, Beer, Branscombe and Lyme Regis all accessible within 10 to 15 miles.

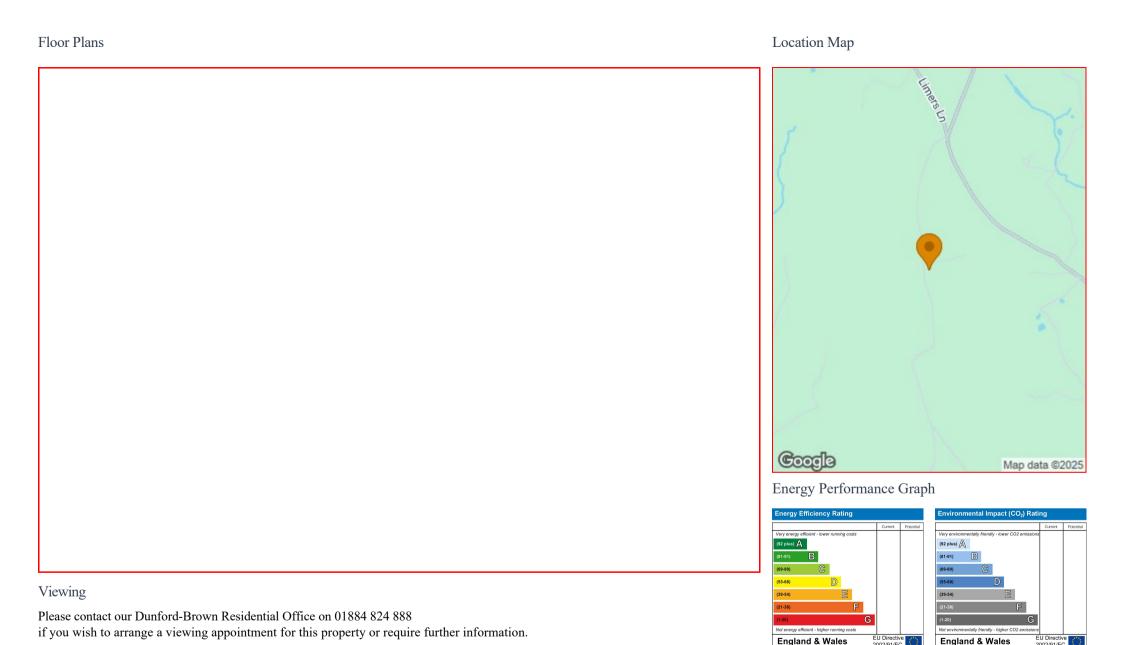
