



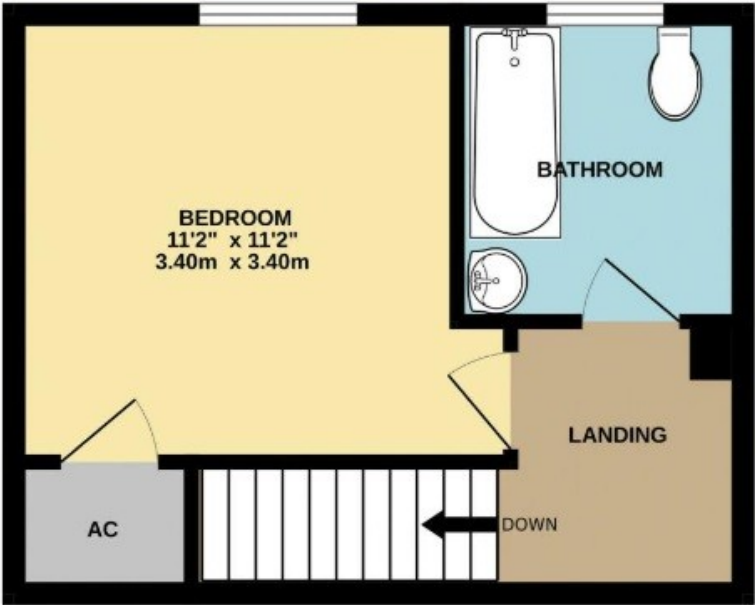

Description

Situated just a stones thrown from Vivary Park and easy reach of Taunton town centre, is this one bedroom mid-terrace cottage which is offered to the market with no onward chain.

The accommodation, which is arranged over two floors is warmed via a mains gas fired central heating system.

Externally, there is a small courtyard garden which is currently laid to timber decking. Internal inspection is essential to fully appreciate this fantastic home.

The property comprises in brief; front door leading into entrance porch with door into the living room. The living room has windows with aspect to the front and rear, stairs leading to the first floor, an understairs storage cupboard and an electric fire with surround. The kitchen offers a selection of matching wall and base storage units with work surfaces above, stainless steel sink with hot and cold mixer tap, space for an electric oven, an integrated washing machine and space for an under counter fridge. The ground floor accommodation is completed with a useful cloakroom with low level WC and a wash hand basin.

On the first floor, the bedroom is a good size double with an integrated wardrobe/storage cupboard. The white bathroom suite comprises low level wc, wash hand basin, panelled 'P' shaped bath with a shower over and a heated towel rail Externally, there is a small area of courtyard garden which is laid to timber decking. The property is offered to the market with vacant possession and no onward chain.
