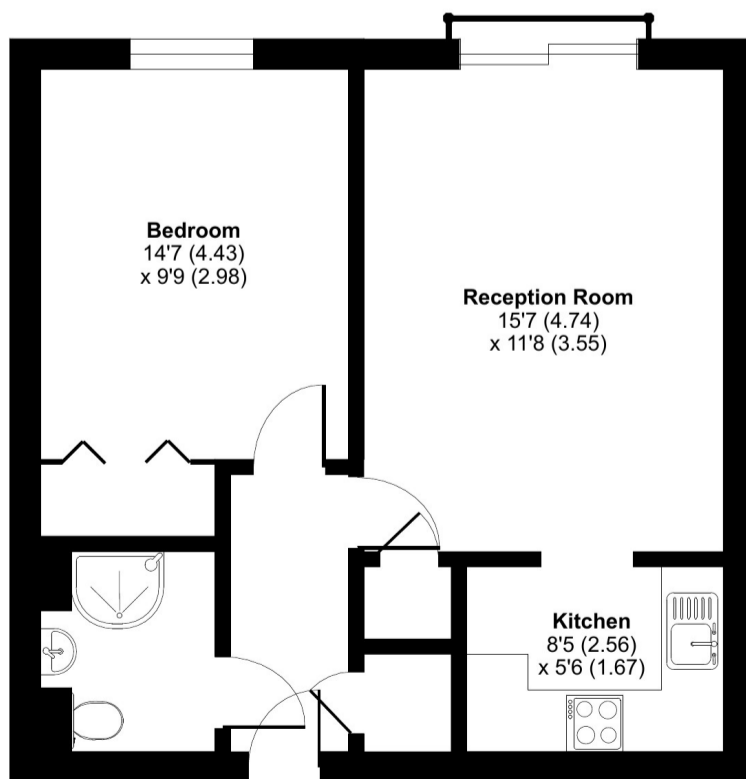

Description

There is a fitted kitchen with matching wall and base units, work surfaces and tiled splashbacks with space for cooker and tall fridge/freezer, as well as a slimline dishwasher. There is a generous size double bedroom with built-in wardrobes and a shower room comprising of wc, wash hand basin, walk-in shower with tiled surround and electric shower.

Externally, Beech Court is set in communal gardens with residents parking that is administered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Within Beech Court, residents have use of the guest suite (subject to charges), communal laundry, residents lounge, conservatory and kitchen as well as the benefit and peace of mind of an on-site resident manager.
