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

There is also a partially floored large Fitted with a range of modern base and wall mounted units, complementary work surfaces over, stainless steel sink & drainer, electric double oven, electric hob with stainless steel extractor hood over, tiled splash backs, space for freestanding fridge/freezer, plumbing for washing machine, space for tumble dryer, space for dining furniture, radiator, window to the front elevation and laminate flooring.
