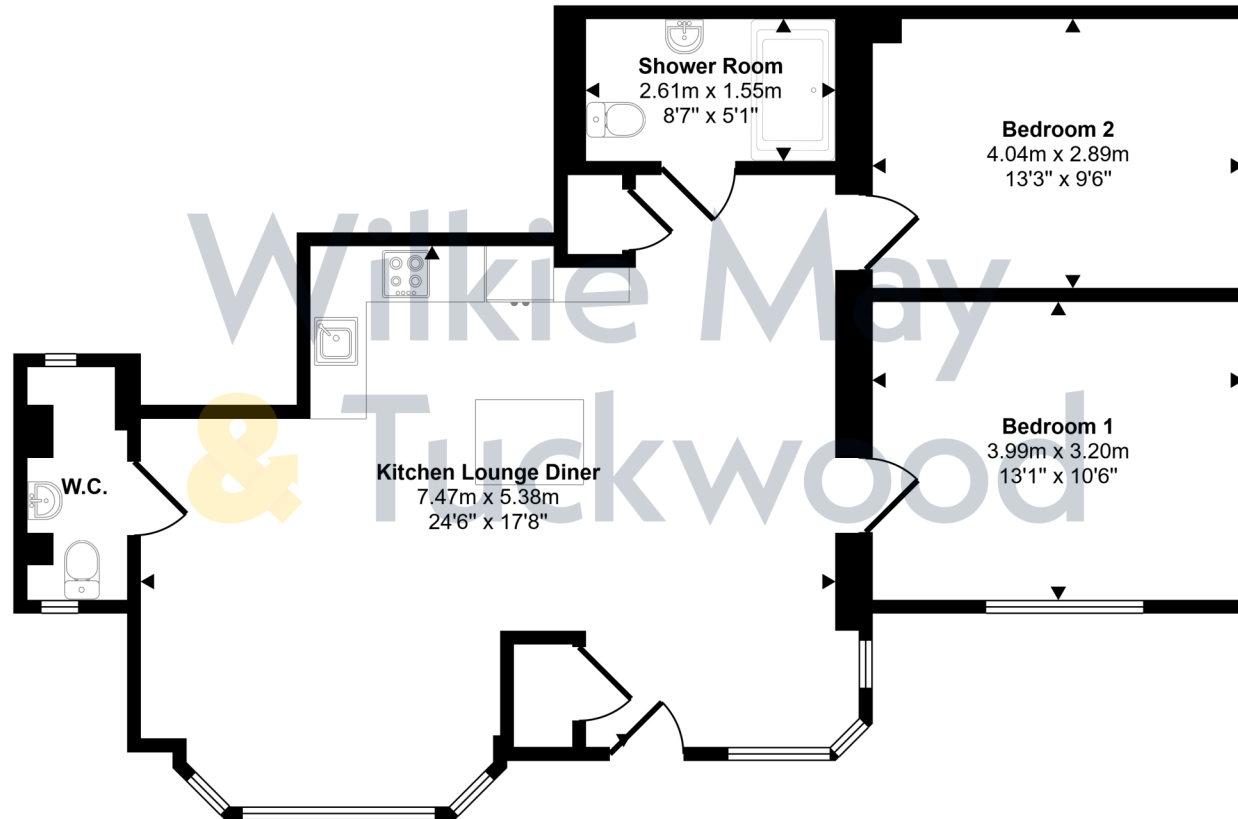

The accommodation comprises in brief: entrance through private front door into the large open plan living, dining, kitchen which has been laid with parquet flooring throughout and has a large bay window to the front.

The kitchen area is fitted with a modern range of wall and base units, sink and drainer incorporated into work surface, island unit and integrated appliances to include a double oven, gas hob with extractor hood over, fridge freezer and dishwasher.



From the open plan living area, doors open to the fitted cloakroom which also houses the gas fired boiler, bedrooms and shower room.

Bedroom 1 has a window to the front.

Bedroom 2 has a window to the side. The shower room fitted with a modern suite comprising shower cubicle, pedestal wash hand basin and low level wc. There are marble tiles on the walls and floor and a heated towel rail.
