This semi-detached home has been REFURBISHED THROUGHOUT by the current owners, to include new kitchen and shower room, radiators, windows, carpets and driveway, whilst situated in a sought-after cul-de-sac in Werrington offering a private garden to the rear. The well presented accommodation comprises of an entrance hall, spacious lounge diner, modern kitchen re-fitted by the current owner approximately four years ago, downstairs bedroom which could be utilised as a second reception room, contemporary downstairs shower room (also re-fitted by the current owner), with the generous main bedroom located to the first floor. Outside the driveway, which was re-fitted by the current owner approximately three years ago, offers parking for multiple vehicles, whilst the well maintained garden to the rear is private, enclosed and boasts an insulated shed with power and electrics hosting the potential for a workshop or external office.

This home is situated within walking distance of green space and benefits from being non-overlooked to the rear, whilst Werrington itself is surrounded by countryside, yet still easily accessible to the city centre of Peterborough.
