TENANT FEES ACT 2019

As well as paying the rent, you may also be required to make the following permitted payments.

For properties in England, the RIGHT TO RENT Tenant Fees Act 2019 means Each applicant will be subject charge tenants (or anyone acting on the tenant's behalf) the following permitted payments:

- Holding deposits (a maximum of 1 week's rent);
- deposit of 5 weeks' rent for annual rent below £50,000, or 6 weeks' rent for annual rental of £50,000 and above);
- · Payments to change a tenancy agreement eg. change of sharer (capped at £50 or, if higher, any reasonable costs);
- · Payments associated with early termination of a tenancy (capped at the landlord's loss or the agent's reasonably incurred costs);
- · Where required, utilities (electricity, gas or other fuel,

water, sewerage), Portsmouth City Council: communication services £864.99 Hampshire Fire & (telephone, internet, Rescue: £45.14 Police and cable/satellite television), TV

- · Council tax (payable to the billing authority);
- · Interest payments for the late payment of rent (up to 3% above Bank of England's annual percentage rate);
- Reasonable costs for replacement of lost keys or other security devices;
- · Contractual damages in the event of the tenant's default of a tenancy agreement; and
- Any other permitted payments under the Tenant Fees Act 2019 and regulations applicable at the relevant




