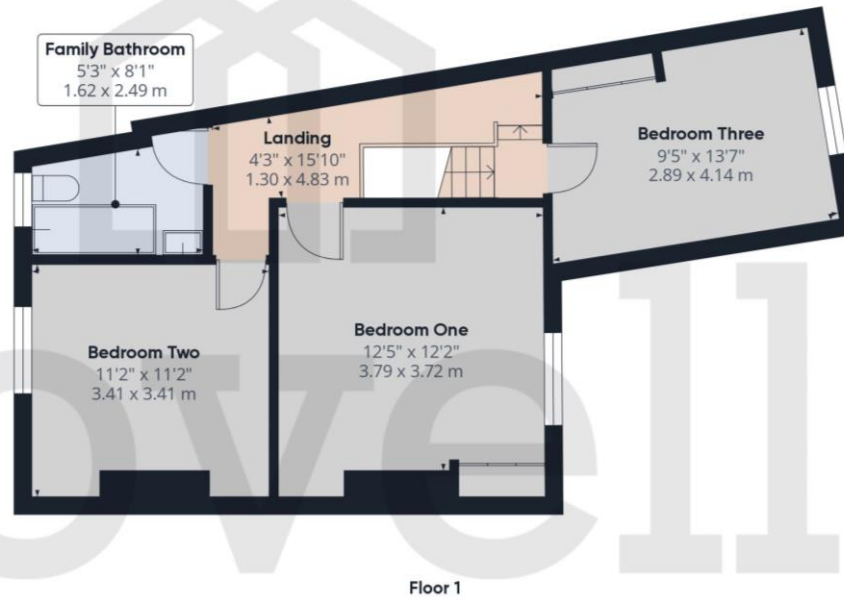
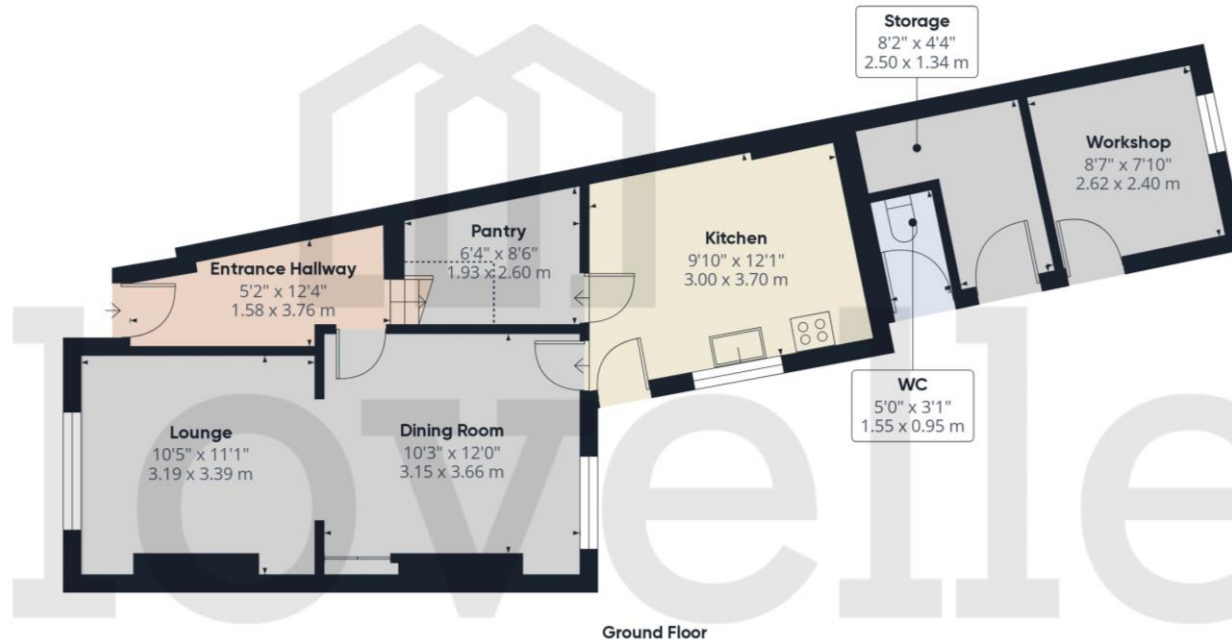

ENTRANCE 1.58m x 3.76m (5'2" x 12'4")
