DESCRIPTION

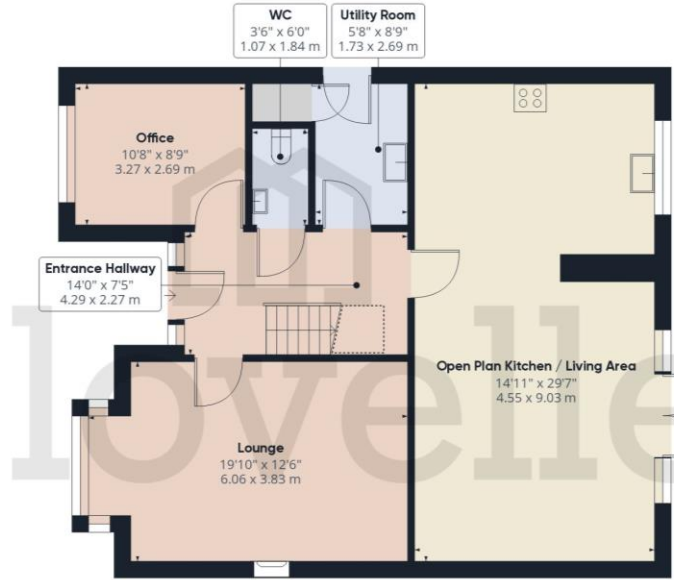
Falkland Way is an attractive development of stylish and charming properties. Hidden on the development is this detached five bedroom home. Boasting well stylish accommodation over three floors.

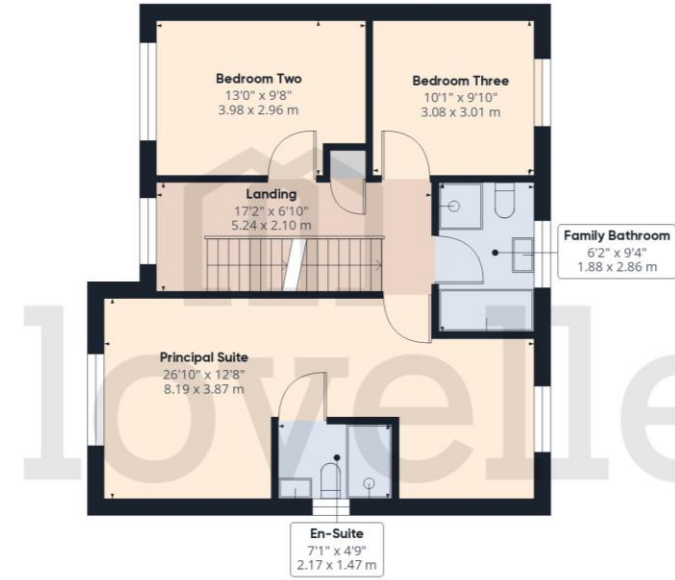

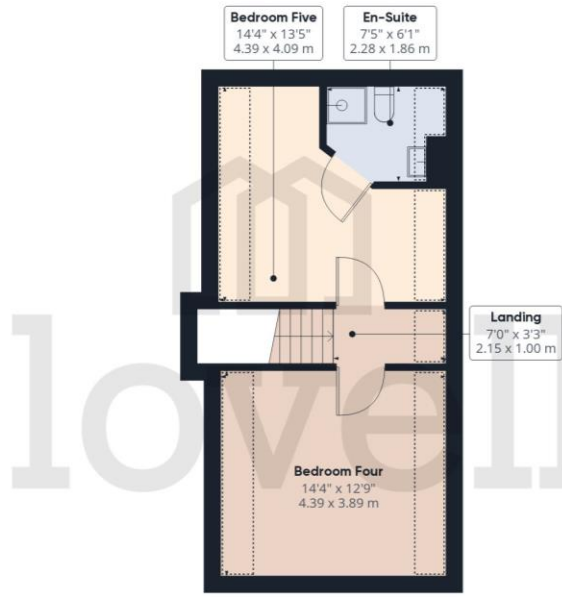
FLOORPLAN



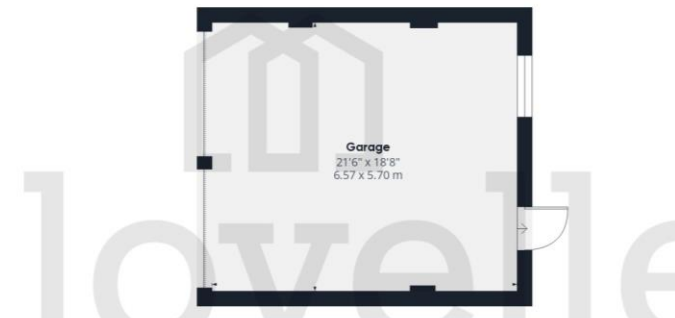
Ground Floor Building 1

ENTRANCE 4.2m x 2.2m

Entered through a composite door with sidelights into the hallway. Doors to all principal rooms and a staircase to further accommodation.

LOUNGE 6m x 3.8m

Bright room with a feature inglenook fireplace with a wooden mantel piece, adding some rustic charm to this space.

Walk in bay window to the front elevation.

OFFICE 3.2m x 2.6m

Window to the front elevation.

OPEN PLAN KITCHEN / LIVING AREA 4.5m x 9m:

KITCHEN

Range of wall and base units in a gloss grey finish with contrasting quartz work surfaces and upstands. Inset one and a half bowl sink and drainer with a swan neck mixer tap. Two Neff eye level ovens and a five ring gas hob with extraction canopy over. Built in dishwasher, fridge freezer and a wine cooler.

"Picture" window to the rear elevation and a breakfast bar.

LIVING / DINING AREA

Spacious dining / living area for the whole family to enjoy or entertain guests. Flooded with light thanks to the double opening French doors overlooking the rear garden and further two roof windows.

UTILITY ROOM 1.7m x 2.6m

Minimalistic range of base units with a contrasting work surface and upstands. Plumbing for a washing machine and space for a tumble dryer. Stainless steel sink and drainer with a swan neck mixer tap. Half glazed UPVC door to the side elevation and a storage cupboard. Housing the combination boiler.

WC 1m x 1.8m

Two piece suite incorporating a push button WC and a pedestal wash hand basin with decorative tiled splash back.

BEDROOM

Window to the front elevation and door to the en-suite.

DRESSING ROOM

Window overlooking the rear garden.

EN-SUITE *2.1m x 1.4m*

Three piece suite incorporating a walk in shower cubicle with a rain shower over, push button WC and a pedestal wash hand basin with a mixer tap. Decorative ceramic tiles to the wet areas. Window to the side elevation.

BEDROOM TWO *3.9m x 2.9m*

Window to the front elevation.

BEDROOM THREE *3m x 3m*

Window to the rear elevation.

FAMILY BATHROOM *1.8m x 2.8m*

Four piece bathroom suite incorporating a bathtub with a mixer tap, corner shower cubicle with a shower over, vanity wash hand basin with a mixer tap and a push button WC. Decorative tiles to the wet areas and a chrome effect towel rail radiator. Window to the rear elevation.

SECOND FLOOR ACCOMMODATION:

BEDROOM FOUR *4.3m x 3.8m*

Two roof windows to the rear elevation and eaves storage access.

BEDROOM FIVE *4.3m x 4m*

Two roof windows to the rear elevation, door to the en-suite.

EN-SUITE *2.2m x 1.8m*

Three piece suite incorporating a corner shower cubicle with a shower over, push button WC and a pedestal wash hand basin with a mixer tap. Decorative ceramic tiles to the wet areas. Roof window to the rear elevation.

Simple front garden, predominantly landscaped with mature shrubbery and plantings with a block paved driveway to the side offering ample off street parking for multiple vehicles. Access to the garage and the rear garden.
