There is also a number of cafés, restaurants and award-winning pubs, so whether you're looking for refreshments on a day's shopping, dinner with friends or an honest pint, there's something for you.

Staying entertained is made easy with a long list of things to do in and around the town. For families there are plenty of kids' activities available, including sports clubs, soft play, the museum and a number of playgrounds.

It's also easy to enjoy the outdoors in Thame, with a great choice of parks and greenery. Elms Park and Thame Park provide lots of open space, whilst Cuttle Brook Nature Reserve makes the perfect place for a relaxing stroll.

The Phoenix Trail can also be easily accessed. This 7.5-mile walking and cycling track is a popular way to take in the beautiful Oxfordshire scenery. Alternatively, you can be in the spectacular Chiltern Hills in around 10 minutes by car.

For more choice, the A418 and M40 connect you to the city of Oxford and its fantastic array of shopping and entertainment in as little as 30 minutes. Alternatively, the attractive towns of High Wycombe and Aylesbury are a similar distance away or you can catch a train to London Marylebone in 45 minutes from nearby Haddenham & Thame Parkway Station.
