Upon entering, a useful storage cupboard off the hallway provides practical space for coats and everyday items. The open-plan kitchen and reception room sits to the left, featuring floor-to-ceiling windows and access to a private balcony offering elevated views across Kingston's urban landscape. The principal bedroom benefits from a generous walk-in wardrobe and private en-suite bathroom, while a well-proportioned second bedroom and separate bathroom complete the accommodation.

The location proves equally compelling - Kingston Station sits just 350 yards away, providing connections to London Waterloo, while Kingston Bridge lies within half a mile, offering easy access to the verdant expanses of Hampton Court Park and Bushy Park beyond. 
Floorplan
