Due for completion in late 2019, this 22.5-acre rail terminal will be capable of handling sixteen 775m-long freight trains daily and will provide storage for over 5,000 TEU. The first rail freight interchange in the East Midlands, it will connect to the Castle Donington freight line and provide access to the UK's network of Rail Freight Interchanges and all major UK ports including Southampton, Felixstowe, London Gateway and the Channel Tunnel.

SLPEMG has been chosen as the site to house its headquarters with planning underway to build a new 20,000 sq ft operations hub. This will house operations staff and state-of-the-art training facilities along with container and curtainsider transport operation on site; HGV parking and fantastic environmental credentials combining rail and Euro 6 vehicles, whilst also installing facilities for electric trucks within the future.
