Property Description

Entering the property there is a porch area leading into a bright entrance hallway. To the right is a fantastic sized living room with large bay window to the front providing the room with a glow of natural light.

Situated to the rear of the property there is a large open plan kitchen living space with French doors leading out into the well maintained, landscaped garden. The kitchen features white gloss, handless, cabinetry and a feature island which can be used as the perfect place to enjoy breakfast. This room has ample space for a corner sofa and dining table and benefits from a vaulted ceiling with Velux windows.

Completing the ground floor there is a handy utility room, shower room as well as a good-sized double bedroom which has a lovely outlook over the garden.

To the front of the property, access either internally through the utility, or externally from the front of the property is a useful storage room. To the first floor there are two double bedrooms both with ample storage space as well as a tiled family shower room and ideal office space or fourth bedroom.

Outside

To the front of the property there is a gravelled driveway providing off street parking for at least 2 cars. The enclosed rear garden has a gravelled path leading to the covered outdoor dining and seating area, the perfect space for entertaining or relaxing in the afternoon sun. There is a lawned area, well planted raised borders and space for a storage shed.

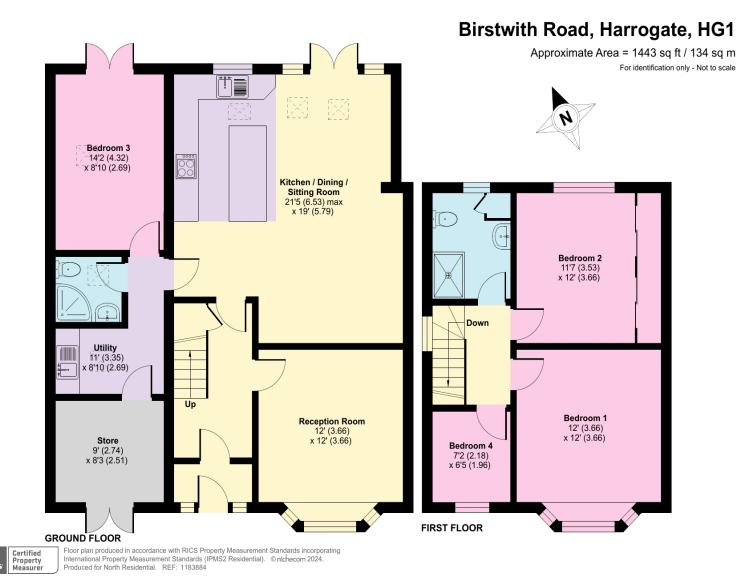
Directions
