


Norwich and Ipswich. There are also daily train services to London Liverpool Street.

There are plenty of convenient village amenities too, such as a family butchers, a well-stocked supermarket, various takeaway's, a library, a primary school, a village hall and a community centre which has many sports clubs and activities. Larger amenities and shops are easily accessible in the nearby towns of Stowmarket and Bury St Edmunds which welcomes a regular market as well as the annual Christmas market.

On your doorstep is a gateway to some of Mid-Suffolk's most breath-taking countryside. There is a wildlife and hiking area at Kiln Meadow where three types of orchids grow, and the pond is a magnet for wildlife. There is also a nature reserve known as Luke's Wood and a children's play area located on Hall Lane.

Families moving to Bloor Homes at Elmswell will appreciate the wide choice of schools for all ages in the surrounding area.



0.5 MILE

A14

You are just minutes from the A14 trunk road, connecting you to nearby towns such as Bury St. Edmunds, Ipswich and Cambridge.

0.3 MILE

Elmswell Station

The station is just a short walk or drive from home, with regular services to Ipswich, Bury St. Edmunds, Cambridge, Norwich and London Liverpool Street.

6 MILES

Stowmarket Town Centre

Stowmarket is a market town and centre of trade for the surrounding area, providing a full range of shopping, banking facilities and more.

6.5 MILES

The Regal Cinema, Theatre & Cafe

The Regal is an independent 3 auditorium cinema and theatre. The venue is owned and run by Stowmarket Town Council and is a real cornerstone of the town, much loved by the local community.

11 MILES

Bury St. Edmunds

Known as the jewel in the Crown of Suffolk, Bury St. Edmunds boasts 1,000 years of history to explore, with award winning restaurants, fantastic shopping, annual festivals and stunning parks.

4.1 MILES

Stowmarket Golf Club

Founded in 1902, Stowmarket Golf Club is a pretty parkland course set in the quiet and peaceful Suffolk countryside.

12.4 MILES

Ickworth National Trust

Ickworth House is a country house at Ickworth, near Bury St. Edmunds, Suffolk, England. It is a neoclassical building set in miles of parkland with rolling landscape, ancient woodlands and working farmland.

0.4 MILES

The Fox Elmswell

Situated in the centre of the village. As well as a popular restaurant serving Thai food, there is a sports bar and outdoor patio area to enjoy refreshments during the summer months.

Blackbourne Community Centre

The Community Centre is a hive of activity during the week, hosting various sports activities as well as groups and events that the local community can enjoy.
