The Home -

Located on Meeson Street, this charming three-bedroom Victorian mid-terraced house features spacious, light-filled living areas, a sleek kitchen-diner with garden access and cosy bedrooms adorned with period features such as fireplaces and cornicing. Located near Chatsworth Road with its vibrant array of independent shops, cafes, and eateries. It's a short distance from the cultural and creative hub of Hackney Wick, the lush green spaces of Daubeney Fields, Hackney Marshes and the Olympic Park's world-class amenities, plus the River Lea are all moments away. With excellent transport links via Homerton station, this home is perfect for those seeking a harmonious blend of urban living and community charm.



The Indoors -

Walking into the entrance way it's adorned with elegant cornicing, a timeless feature. The hallway sets a welcoming tone with its high ceilings and soft lighting, guiding you through the property with ease. To the left, enter the extensive living space where tradition meets comfort. The dual Victorian fireplaces create focal points of warmth. Triple bay double glazed windows illuminate the room, flooding it with natural light that dances off every surface, making this the perfect spot to unwind or entertain.

Continue down the hallway to a spacious kitchen and dining area. The tiled flooring enhances practicality, while the layout is designed for effortless flow. The dining space enjoys abundant light from triple bay windows and dual garden-access doors, blurring the line between indoor and outdoor living. The kitchen is both functional and stylish, offering plentiful storage and featuring an integrated cooker and oven.

Adjacent to the kitchen, a utility area ensures the home remains tidy and organized. The nearby W/C adds convenience without compromising on design.

Upstairs, the first-floor hosts three bedrooms and a bathroom. The generously sized main bedroom accommodates a double bed and space for wardrobes, enhanced by a Victorian fireplace and two large windows that bathe the room in light. The second bedroom equally as cosy, this bedroom features another Victorian fireplace and room for a double bed, complemented by natural brightness, whilst the third bedroom could be perfect as a guest room, nursery, or home office, the third bedroom retains the home's cosy charm. The main bathroom exudes sophistication with its concealed shower, intricate tiling, and sleek, modern fixtures. Ample windows keep the space light and airy.

The Outdoors -

Loving The Location

Chatsworth Road runs north from Homerton towards the green fields of Clapton and the Marshes. It offers a selection of independent shops, cafes and restaurants such as Shanes and Fika, and specialist food suppliers L'épicerie.

Hackney Wick is nearby and lies between Victoria Park and the River Lee. Once a bustling industrial area, it now draws an eclectic and creative crowd. Since the 2012 Olympics, it has seen a significant influx of cultural investment, with new developments and facilities in easy reach of this house. There are numerous restaurants and bars, including the Michelin-starred Cornerstone, as well as Silo and Crate Brewery.

The Here East campus, The Breakfast Club, Randy's Wings, Mother and Gotto is a short walk away and operates as a co-working hub and cultural centre, while award-winning theatre and music venue The Yard is also close by.

The amenities of the Olympic Park are close at hand, where the East Bank, a new world-class cultural quarter, is now under construction, with new facilities for the V&A Museum, Sadler's Wells Theatre, the BBC and the London College of Fashion, as well as a new campus for UCL.

Homerton station, is minutes away and runs direct services to Stratford and Highbury & Islington on the London Overground.







Floor Plans
