

The property was formerly the Wagon and Horses public house. The property is of local stone and brick built construction under a part thatched and part slate roof. The accommodation benefits from oak flooring to the ground floor, built in air conditioning system to all bedrooms and gas central heating with under floor heating to part of the ground floor.
