The Grade II listed former public house known as The Three Tuns has enormous potential, situated on the popular high street of Alcester. The Three Tuns sustained significant fire damage in 2021. The building is now ripe for redevelopment with listed building consent approved, subject to some conditions for reinstatement works after the fire damage. Alcester is a popular market town offering a range of local amenities, such as national retailers including Specsavers and Superdrug. The town sits approximately eight miles from Stratford-upon-Avon, famous as the birthplace of William Shakespeare, and home to the Royal Shakespeare Theatre and attracts almost four million visitors a year. Stratford-upon-Avon is also a prosperous riverside market town with fine restaurants and pubs, a good choice of schools and excellent sporting and recreational amenities. The town is ideally placed for access to the M40, other major road and rail networks, and Birmingham International Airport.



