

The Old Bakery is a beautifully renovated Cotswold stone cottage dating back to the 1840s, set just moments from Moreton-in-Marsh with its direct rail links to London Paddington. Carefully modernised while retaining its character, the cottage showcases exposed beams, stone walls and a striking inglenook fireplace with log burner, all balanced with contemporary finishes for comfortable living.

The accommodation is thoughtfully laid out, with a welcoming living room featuring oak floors and the original fireplace, a newly fitted kitchen with adjoining dining area, and a ground floor family bathroom with both bath and shower. Upstairs, the three bedrooms are individually styled: the main bedroom with a king-size bed, a third bedroom with a bespoke single cabin bed, and a generous top-floor twin that spans an impressive 23 feet.

Outside, the property enjoys a large private garden, complemented by a log cabin that serves as a utility room with washer, dryer and storage space. A single garage, additional store and off-street parking for multiple vehicles add further convenience.

Blending historic charm with modern comfort, The Old Bakery offers a characterful retreat in the Cotswolds, combining peaceful village living with excellent connections to London and beyond.
