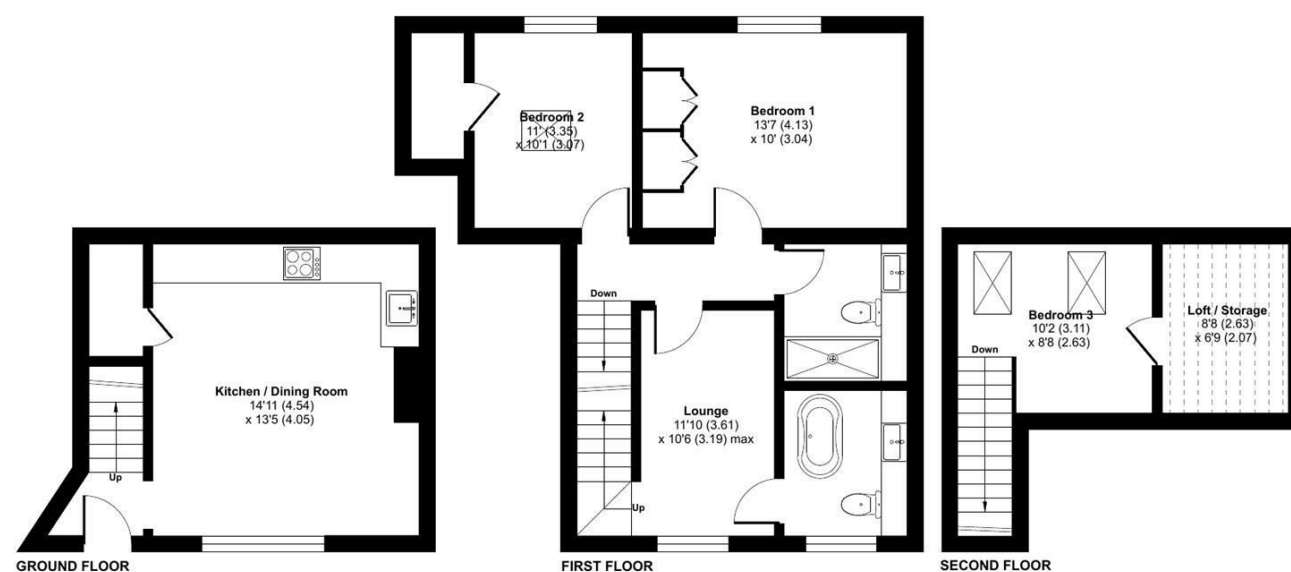

Cherry Cottage High Street, Bisley GL6 7BA

Bisley is a charming Cotswold village located near Cheltenham, about 4 miles from Stroud and within easy reach of Cirencester. Perched on a hilltop in the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, it's known for its traditional stone cottages, peaceful lanes, and beautiful countryside views.
