



North Street, Oundle

Set on North Street, the oldest street in Oundle, this three-bedroom stone cottage has a Collyweston tiled roof and was built circa C14.

The entrance door is tucked away down the side and opens into the good-sized kitchen dining room with stable door opening onto the garden, a range of cream wall and base cupboards with solid wood worktops and room for a dining table and chairs. To the front of the cottage is the living room with two windows, a window seat, wooden flooring and a beautiful open fireplace. Carpeted stairs rise to the first floor where two double bedrooms can be found as well as a stylish bathroom in keeping with the age of the property. A further set of stairs leads to the double bedroom on the second floor that has a lovely wooden floor.

Externally there is a garden with ample room for entertaining and enjoying the peaceful surrounds. Two brick built stores are positioned at the back of the garden.

The current owners have lovingly maintained the property and have gained Listed Building Consent for a utility and shower room.
