An interview with Ed Tyack



As our principle architect, what helps to shape your vision for an Inspired Village like Gifford Lea?

Well first of all, every village is different. It simply has to be. Because the architectural design must be sympathetic and suited to its environment.

So we think about the local design language, research any indigenous building materials, and make sure that every architectural detail is inspired and enriched by its surroundings.

Are there any ways of ensuring that a new development feels like an authentic village community?

There aren't any guarantees, although thoughtful design and planning really can help a development become a true community. Our villages tend to be created around a central square which naturally becomes a social hub; just as a market square or village green would in a rural settlement. We give preference to pedestrians not motor cars – these are places for families, friendships and laughter – not traffic!

Do you have much involvement with all the beautiful landscaping around the village grounds?

In short, yes! It's important that the natural landscape and the physical architecture feels entwined. So we work closely with the landscaping team to make sure the natural beauty of Tattenhall can be appreciated from both the private apartments and the communal facilities. We want the buildings to blend into their surroundings, so we're always looking for new ways of achieving that aim.
