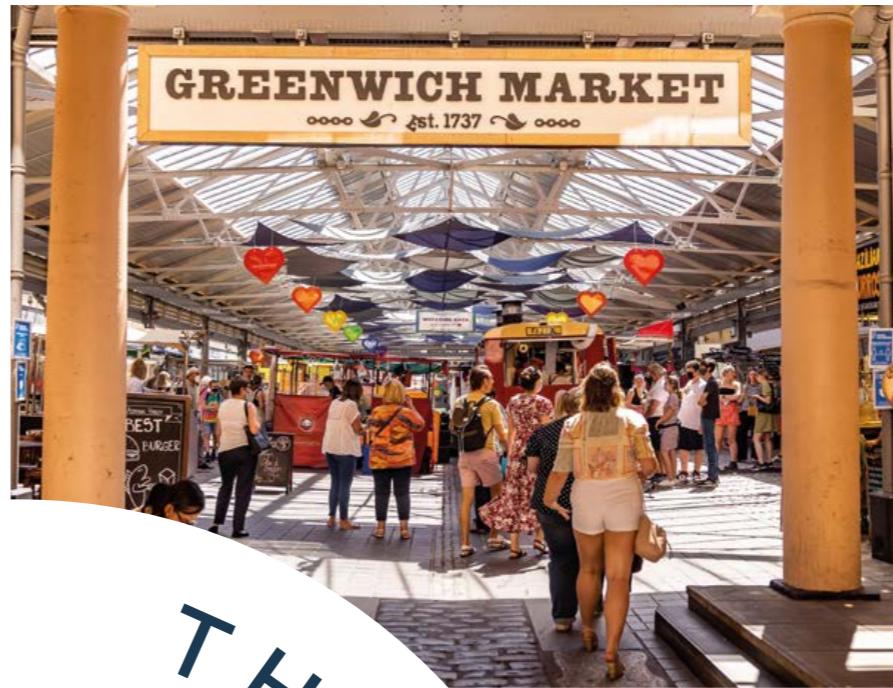

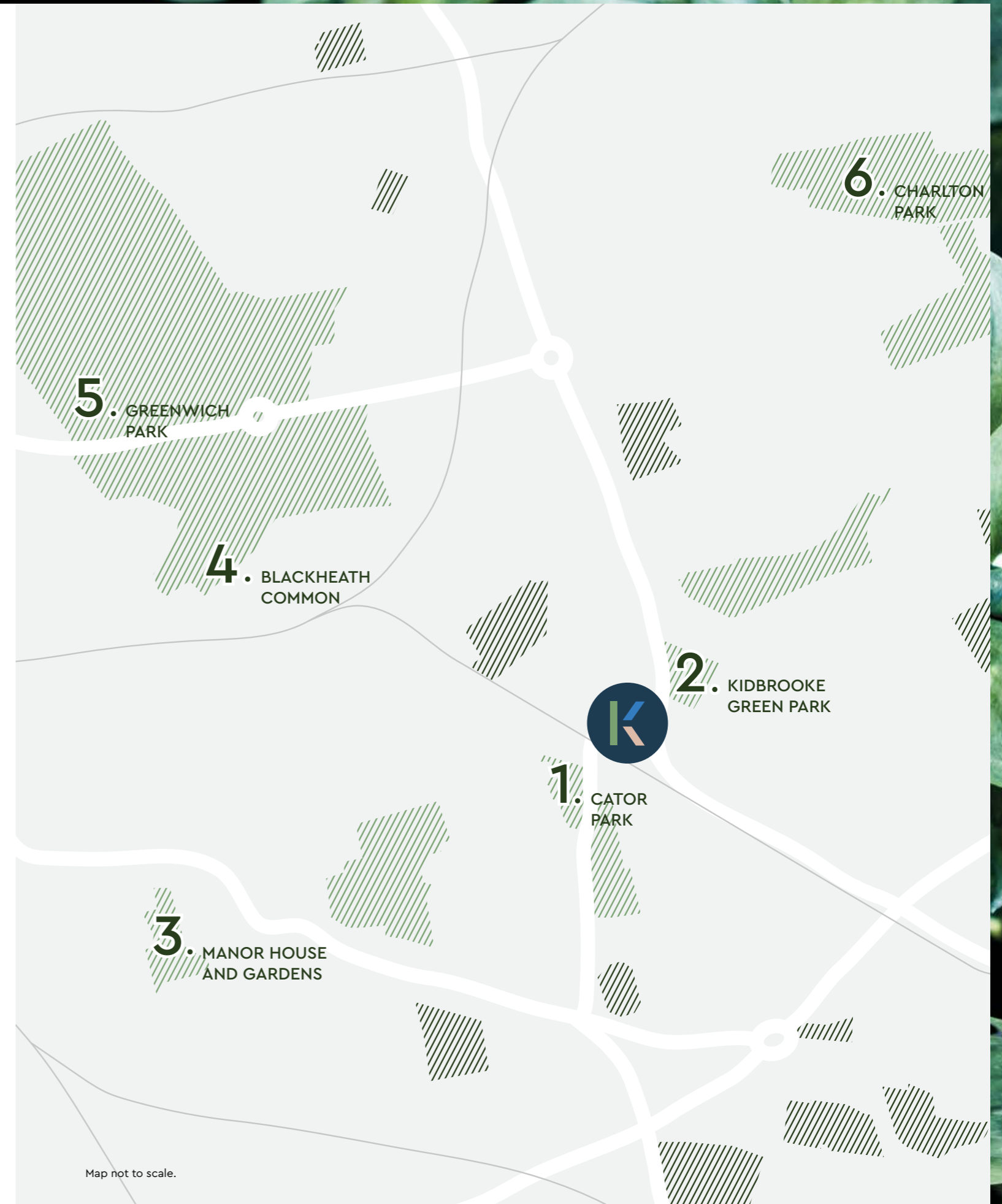

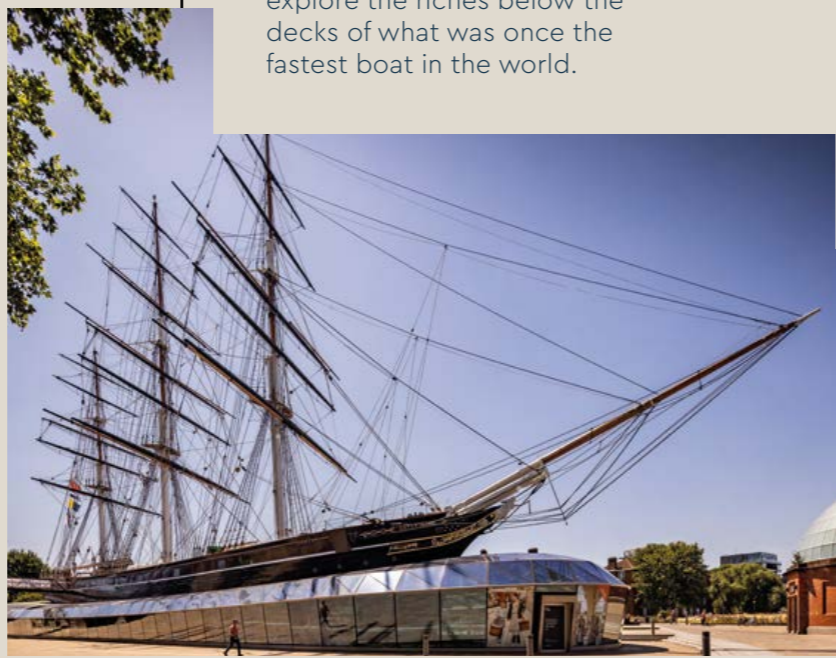
GREENWICH PRIME MERIDIAN

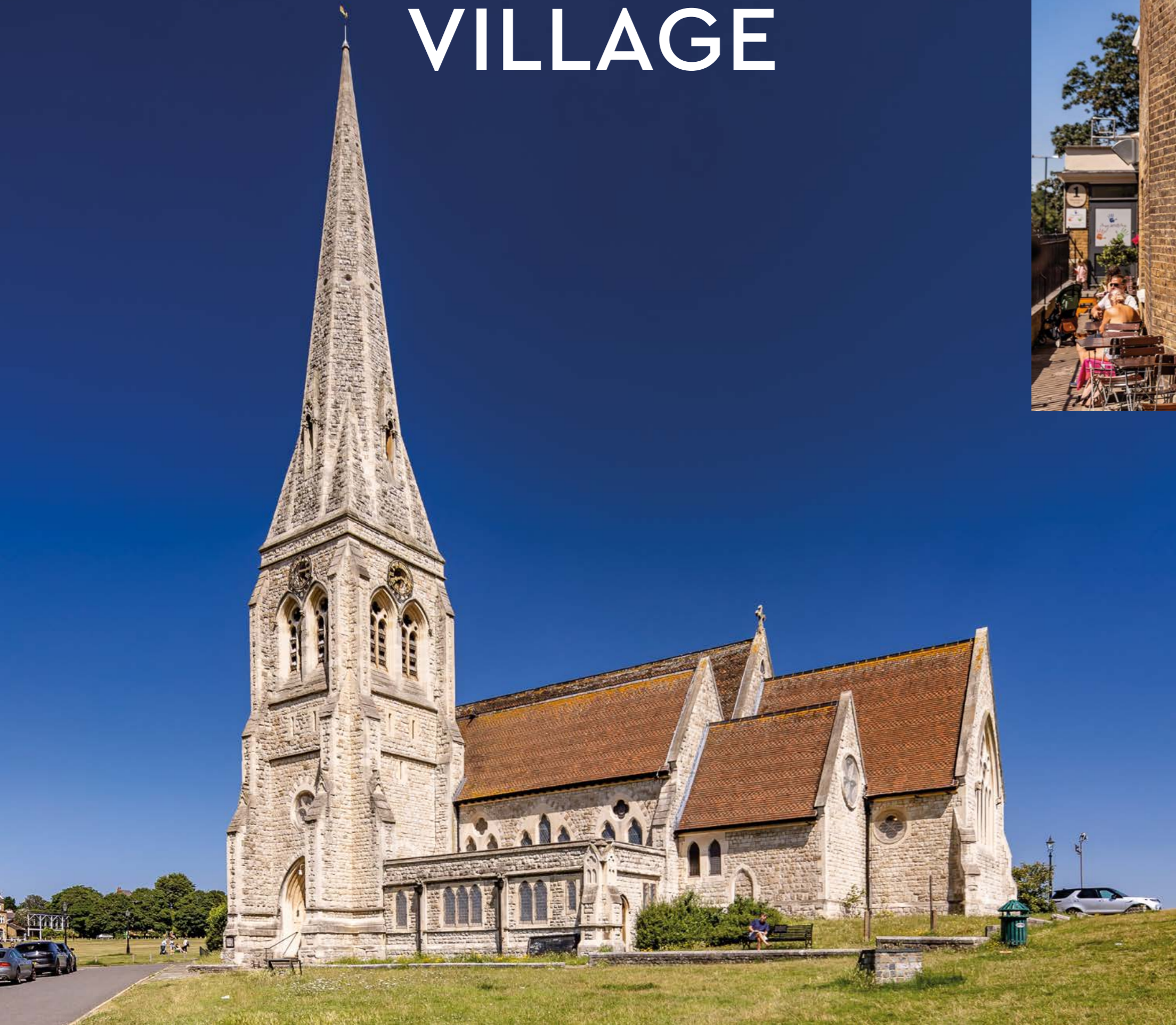
GREENWICH MARKET

Kidbrooke has had a railway station since 1895. Today, the new station is operated by Southeastern and is in Zone 3. Trains run to London Charing Cross, Victoria and Cannon Street from its two platforms as well as into leafy Surrey and Kent and beyond.
