


Winkfield Hall boasts large dual aspect windows throughout that flood the living areas with natural light, creating a very positive ambience.

Both Lambrook and Eton College, pictured below, are invariably choices of the Royal Family.




With such a supportive network, children in Winkfield are well-equipped to thrive both academically and personally.

Proximity to Key Locations

Windsor: Just 4 miles away, Windsor is easily accessible for exploring its historic castle, beautiful parks, and vibrant town centre.

London Heathrow Airport: Approximately 12 miles from Winkfield, the airport is conveniently reachable for international travel.

The M4 allows for easy access to Central London and the West Country and also links to the M25, which in turn provides access to the M3.

Rail access is equally convenient with direct services to London Waterloo available from Ascot and Windsor.

Services direct to London Paddington are from Slough with a connection to Windsor available.

The Crossrail or Elizebeth Line, the new high speed service link through Maidenhead to Heathrow and in to the city.
