This **fabulous spacious family home** has private off road parking for 4 cars and side access. The property enjoys gas mains central heating in a prime location.

The **entrance hall** welcomes you into the house, the staircase takes you up to the bedrooms and family bathroom. There are stairs taking you down to the lounge, kitchen & bar, and sun room. Along the hallway there is access to the self-contained annexe.

The **self-contained annexe** is fabulous. There is a modern kitchen and dining space, a large double bedroom with en-suite shower. This space could be utilised as a rental opportunity. The rooms could be used in different ways to suit your needs.

On the **1st floor** there are 3 bedrooms. The first is a single bedroom / office, bedroom 2 is opposite the staircase and is a good size double looking out over the stunning garden and views. There is a family bathroom with separate shower, modern suite with a hydro bath and tiled walls.

Bedroom 4 is located at the front of the house. This large double bedroom has two windows creating a bright space, and a built in double wardrobe.

The **staircase** takes you up to the top floor primary suite..

The **top floor primary suite** is exquisite, this spacious room has two velux windows and double patio doors to access the **private balcony** to enjoy the views. There is a **walk-in wardrobe** and another storage cupboard. The room benefits from a **large en-suite modern** shower room.

The **lower ground floor** has a spacious lounge with two velux windows, two large windows to the side and double glass patio doors accessing the rear patio and garden.

The **kitchen & bar** is located at the bottom of the stairs. There is lots of units & worktop space. The appliances

are top spec with a gas hob and double oven. The bar features at the end of the kitchen with a seating area to enjoy a drink.

The **sun room** is a fabulous space. The glass surrounding the room gives this spacious room plenty of natural light. There is an electric fire feature and is currently used as a lounge area and dining space. Perfect for family occasions. There are double patio doors to access the rear patio and garden.

The **beautiful private rear garden** is stunning. There is a large slabbed patio space accessed from the lounge and sun room, lawned area with a raised pond, decked area for relaxing and a pool feature. The pathway along the side of the sun room takes you to the garden room and steps leading you up to the private parking.
