A superb opportunity for a first-time buyer in a well-located home with genuine charm and strong long-term appeal.















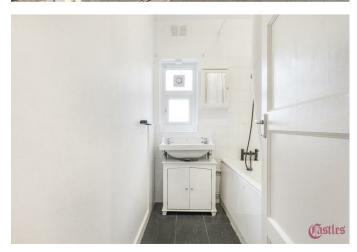

Transport

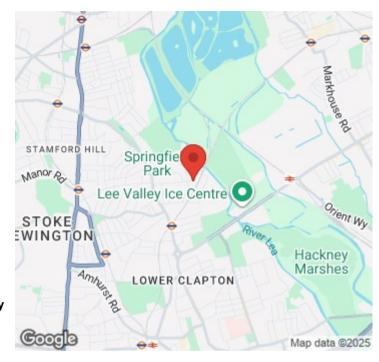
