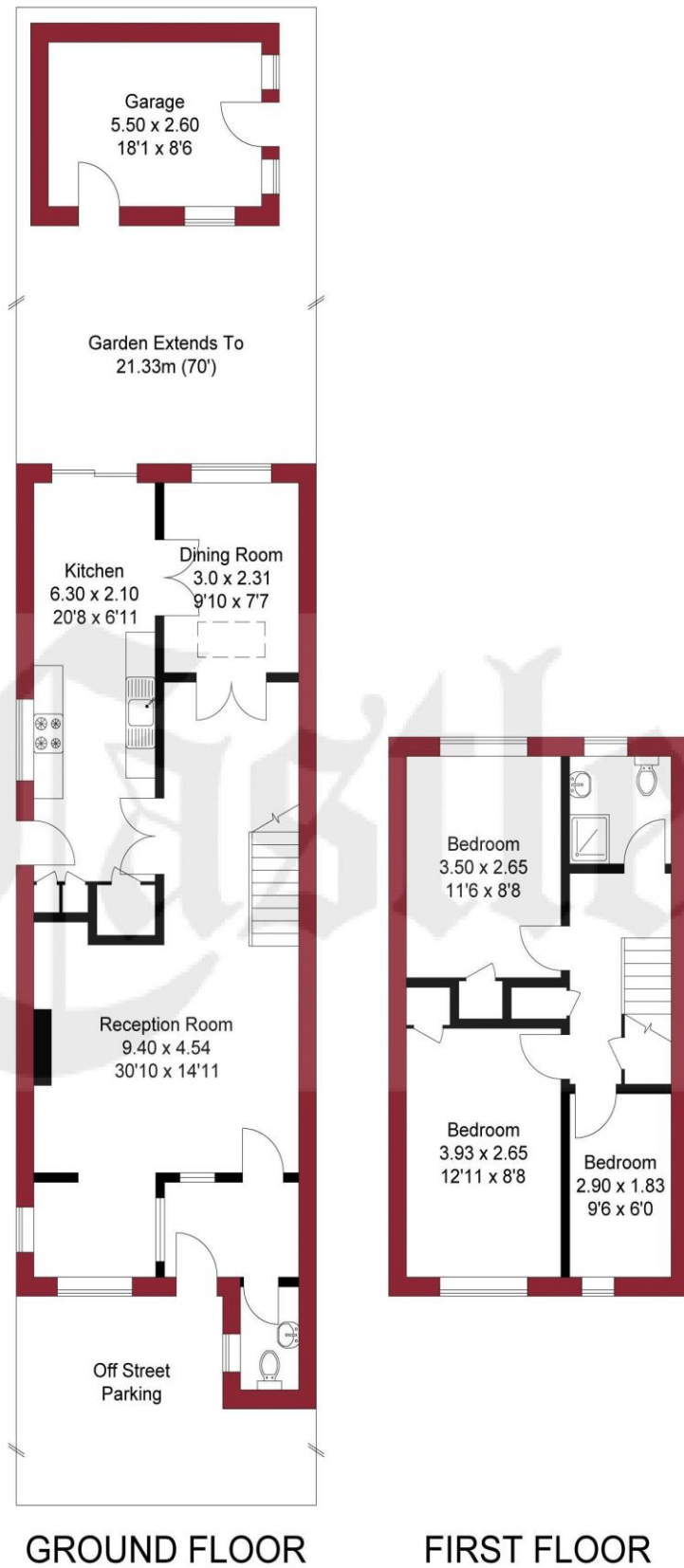

Broxbourne is alive with family-friendly activities and plenty of dog walkers.

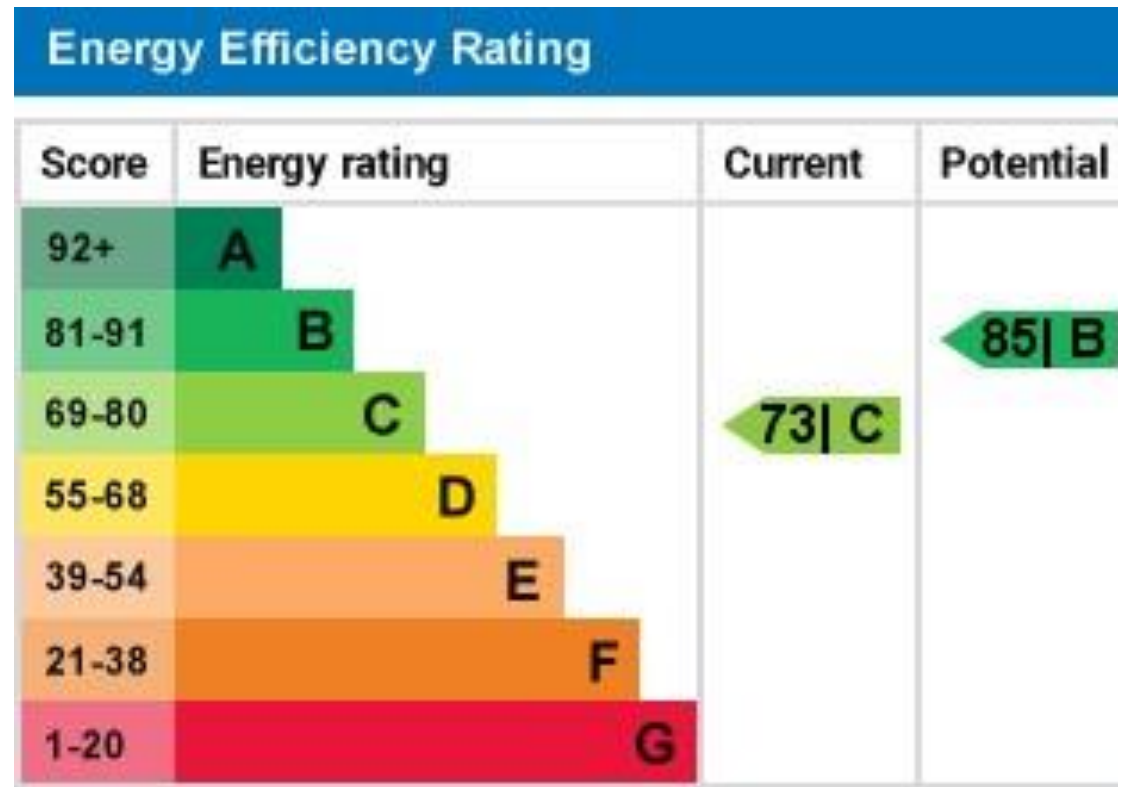
The town is flanked by the A10 and both the River Lea and New Rivers, respectively.
