GROUND FLOOR

Kitchen/Dining Room

4.74m (15'7") x 3.41m (11'2")

Wooden single glazed obscure entrance door to front, wooden single glazed sash window to front, fitted with a matching range of base and eye level units with worktop space over, ceramic Belfast sink, freestanding electric Rangemaster, stairs to first floor with storage under, radiator.

Inner Hallway

Metal frame single glazed window to front, plumbing for washing machine.

Bathroom

Fitted with three-piece suite comprising bath with hand shower attachment, pedestal wash hand basin and low-level WC, extractor fan, heated towel rail.

Boot Room

2.04m (6'8") x 1.88m (6'2")

Wooden obscure single glazed high level window to rear, radiator.

FIRST FLOOR

Wooden single glazed sash windows to front and side, wooden single glazed stable door to rear, feature fireplace with wood burning stove, stairs to second floor, radiator.

SECOND FLOOR

Bedroom

Wooden single glazed window to front, airing cupboard, cupboard, access to loft room with pull down ladder, radiator.

En-Suite Shower Room

Wooden single glazed sash window to side, three piece suite comprising close coupled WC, wash hand basin and shower enclosure.

THIRD FLOOR

Loft Room 4.77m (15'8") x 2.85m (9'4") Accessed from a drop down ladder, single glazed Velux window to rear, radiator, telephone point.

EXTERNALLY

Enclosed rear garden with raised decked area, cold water tap, mature shrubs and flowers, exterior lighting, gated rear access.

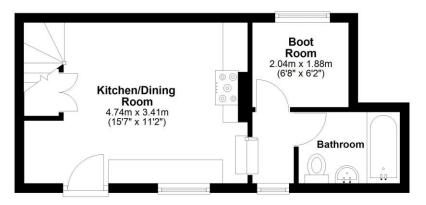




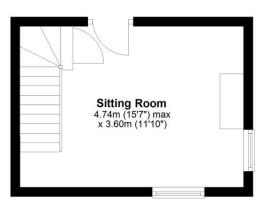

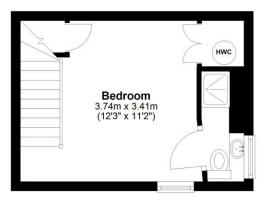
First Floor
