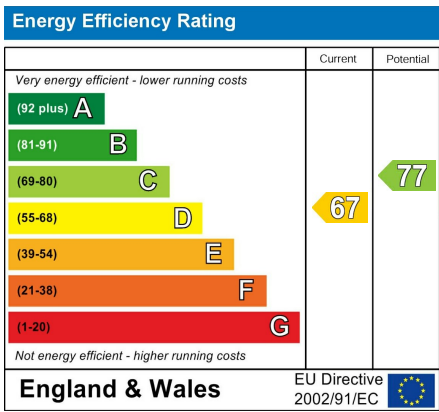


Floor Plan

Description

The Property

With gas fired central heating and double glazing the living accommodation comprises; entrance hall, spacious lounge with feature fireplace with an electric fire, breakfast kitchen with electric cooker, space for freestanding fridge freezer, plumbing for a washing machine and a back door leading out into the rear garden.
